

Note that this is not the same system people use when they pay their bills each month, bills with varying amounts: it is used when the \$ amount is constant from week-to week (or month-to-month.)

RETURN TO THE LORD YOUR GOD

After all the snow, ice and mighty winds, the hope for an early Spring brings us to the month of March. March is a special month because it brings us to the liturgical season of Lent. Lent officially begins on **Ash Wednesday which is March 6**th this year. We will have our traditional **Ash Wednesday soup dinner at 6 p.m**. Why a soup dinner? From what I have been given to understand is that it was because of the simplicity of the meal for which we would begin our Lenten season.

At 7 p.m. we will have our worship service with Communion. The message for the day centers on the real meaning behind Lent. One of the scripture readings for Ash Wednesday is from the second chapter of Joel verse 13b where we are reminded to "Return to the Lord your God, for he is merciful and compassionate, very patient, full of faithful love and ready to forgive."

So how do we return to the Lord with all our hearts? One way is to get back to the basics – that being by taking time to read and study the Bible.

This year we will begin our fifth year of Bible study on March 9th. Our class will be using the book "Simon Peter: Flawed but Faithful Disciple" by Adam Hamilton. Our Bible study classes have given us the opportunity to read and seek understanding from scripture. In addition, some studies have used DVD sessions that have given us examples of other class participations on the topic, or actual scenes through the Holy Land to give us a better idea of where all the transpires.

Our 8th grade Confirmation class has done their own Bible study as they were required to read the whole Gospel of Mark. We have taken time to go through each chapter and discuss what we understand the readings to mean.

One of our Confirmands, *Dorian Schrader* is working on his 3rd religious award in Boy Scouts which centers on "God and Church." One of Dorian's requirements was to take 30 days to read scripture, and Dorian chose to go through the book of Genesis.

There are also a few of our members who have taken it upon themselves to read the whole Bible within a year.

So if you chose to start with Genesis, the Gospel of Mark, or pledge to read the whole Bible within a year – let us all Return to the Lord our God by getting back to reading the Bible.

May God continue to bless you!


