APRIL 23-24, 2022 IS THE NEW DATE FOR BOISE HARVEST!

SAVE THE DATES of April 23-24 for the most life-changing event since Billy Graham visited the Treasure Valley in 1982! After delay of two years, Greg Laurie, of Harvest Ministries, will be at the Extra Mile Arena on the BSU campus in an area-wide evangelistic crusade.

HOW GOD IS WORKING: After Ben Harris, pastor of Restored Community in Eagle, contacted the Harvest team, they took just 4 months to approve our crusade, as opposed to the typical approval time of 18 months. Greg Laurie's team also believes so strongly in our outreach that they committed \$20,000 of their funds to our event, which is an amazing gift. In 2019, our association decided to contribute \$10,000, and encouraged each association church to contribute, as they were able. Although Greg Laurie pastors a Southern Baptist church, we could not do this event just through our association. With over 150 area evangelical churches and ministries participating in this crusade, the response has been tremendous. In spite of the delay, God is still working in the midst of this pandemic.

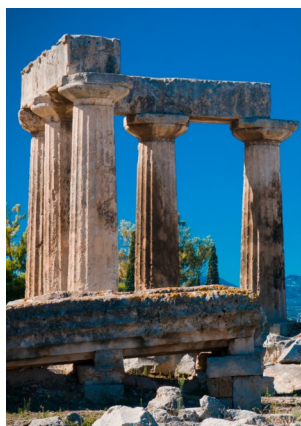
Where Do We Go From Here?

As a former missionary pilot and dad to three kids, knowing where I was going was a rather important thing. We took a number of long road trips across the US, and having a map and a plan was key to answering questions like “When are we going to get there?” or “Are we there yet?” As an association of churches, we need a “map” to guide us to our destination or goal, otherwise we are just a bunch of individual churches who may like to hang out together, but are lacking the power that collaboration can bring for God’s glory. It has been three years since our Director of Missions stepped down. In those three years we have talked about what the TVSBA might look like but we haven’t decided on a “map” yet to help us fulfill the mission of our association.

Our next Executive Board meeting on February 24th at Agua Viva will be an important one. I hope every church will be represented so that we can begin to shape the “map” for the TVSBA. First, the A-Team will be recommending Mike Ellis, pastor/church planter of New Life in Ontario, Oregon, to be our new moderator. Mike has a passion to see the lost of the valley come to Christ and a passion for associational partnering to see this happen. Second, the A-Team will be bringing a motion to move our association to a Teams-led model and ask the association to task the A-Team to revise the Manual of Operations and Constitution to reflect this. This would give direction to the A-Team who would then bring proposed revisions to the July Executive Board Meeting for evaluation and discussion and then these would be voted on by the association at the Annual Meeting in October.
