An Introduction

Hello Treasure Valley Southern Baptist Association. I pray that you are all doing well.

Normally within this section of the newsletter you would be able to read an outstanding article from the moderator or as of late, our vice moderator. Please know that I will make every attempt to follow this great tradition; however, in this article I believe it best to introduce my family and myself.

My name is Mike Ellis. My beautiful, amazing wife of 20 years is Tera and we have 3 wonderful boys, Christian, Josh, and Tommy. We reside in Payette and have done so since 2019. Tera works as a kindergarten teacher at Treasure Valley Classical Academy in Fruitland and our boys are all students in high, middle, and elementary school. Tera and I both grew up in this area; Tera in Parma, and I in Nampa.

Our ministry journey started in 2004 while we lived for a short time is Post Falls, Idaho. It was there that I was baptized and discipled by Pastor Steve Ruth, who happened to be Tera's childhood pastor. One year earlier, I had received Jesus and was saved from a life that was leading me to not only spiritual death but perhaps even a physical death. During that first year of being a Christian I did not receive any discipleship, nor did I regularly attend a church. I was struggling, my marriage of one year was struggling, and Satan had a strangle hold on me. To remedy this Tera and I decided to move away, and that is what brought us to Post Falls. My time there, albeit short, was life-changing. Not only was I baptized, I finally found the true path on which to walk, and had the call to ministry confirmed in my life.

The surrender to ministry led us back to Southwestern Idaho. It was there that I would serve in just about any role in which I was able. I served as a deacon, Sunday school leader, VBS volunteer, camp speaker and so on. While I loved and still cherish those many opportunities, they never completely fulfilled the call that was put upon my life. In 2010 I decided to take the next step and work toward vocational ministry. I started online seminary at Liberty University, but this proved to be difficult while working 65 plus hours a week at my secular job. Tera and I both knew that something needed to change to make this work. After a year of prayer, struggle, and not getting much sleep, God led us to Wyoming. It was a new start and an amazing opportunity. I was blessed with a youth and music ministry while also working and completing seminary.

We were blessed to live in the northeast corner of Wyoming for 8 years. During the course of the last two years of our time there, God was opening doors for us to move to Payette and plant a church here in the western part of the valley, and here we are. We are planting New Life Baptist Church in Ontario. We had started in our living room in September of 2019 just after moving back in July. We quickly out grew that room and due to that we lost people. Everyone knows what came next in the early months of 2020. With covid 19 on the rise we were feeling defeated and tired, but God had a better plan. In April of 2020, I was contacted by Clint Henry with an opportunity of a building. We accepted, and in June of 2020 we held our first service.

Why am I telling you all of this? I believe that God has a great plan for the Treasure Valley. I believe that with the influx of people that are moving to this area we have an extraordinary gift of being able to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ. However, this blessing does not stop there. We can and should be in on the ground floor of building a Jesus Christ centered culture all throughout this valley for our current and next generation of believers. Leave no doubt in your mind though, this will be hard work, but that my friends is the beauty of being a Southern Baptist. What one little church in Ontario, Oregon cannot do on its own, is capable of doing amazing Godly things with other churches that partner with them. Now is the time to come together, united with a common goal of seeing the gospel prosper, churches being planted, real ministry being performed, real needs being met, and Godly love lived out every day. This responsibility falls to us. It is on us to see that not only this generation thrives with God but the next as well. So, lets roll up our sleeves and get to doing what it is that we have all been called to do, and remember that nothing is impossible with God.
