- My Bishop taught from the Book of Joshua in depth about taking authority...taking the city! He illustrated using real Surveying equipment on stage while teaching the message. Possess the land and Survey the Lots. He gave us the updated version of God's Blueprint for "Taking Authority" how to take a city.
- We must combine forces and with God's help take back what belongs to God. We are charged with taking this city and moving out anything that opposes God.
- We should not be competitors to one another in the kingdom, but completion oriented to do our father's work.
- The Gangs and violence in our streets as you know are demons and devils. We must use Prayer and Presence.

 Prayer is for the part we can't do...Presence is for the part we can. "Go and I will go before you," says the Lord.





- We can offer them to come to work for God (disciples) or be cast out. Many will be saved and converted, and they can be trained to rebuild the city they previously tore down. Moses' anointing was to deliver the people, Joshua's anointing was to take them into the Promise. "From Deliverance to Destiny" this is what we are called and anointed to do.
- We need to establish <u>12 Tribes or Groups</u> to operate in their own, gifting and callings, which carries its own anointing. This is God's plan from the Civil Rights era to Present. This will cut down on some of the unnecessary competition amongst our people. We can get deeper into this later, but the point is 12 was important enough to God from the book of Genesis to Revelation.
- Even before the early church could move forward the Apostles replaced Judas (although it was done in a carnal manner by casting lots) none the less, they understood how important the government of 12 is in the kingdom and did not leave the twelfth seat empty.





- The rise of crime in our communities is being committed by our youth. We as the church must offer them better solutions starting with God; of course, but not short of education. We know the statistics of high school dropouts and no intent to attend college.
- We as the church should be front and center to offer incentives to complete at least high school. If college is not on the table for many of them especially our males, then a skill or trade should be offered as an option for everyday living.
- We as the church should spearhead this solution. We see patterns repeatedly in our teens heading in the wrong direction, Gang violence is prevalent because they offer them alternatives that are inclusive though they are detrimental.
- We offer to be present and give them a working and successful model which would involve them in making it happen. Have them participate in the process and progress. Compensate their achievements with tangible rewards.
- Give them the spiritual, ethical, and economic model of success they need, stemming from the church...the total experience.

We won't have enough room to house all the people doing what our forefathers did, hit those streets and **WE CAN** to. Let us train these young people to be warriors for Christ.





- We need the government of God's kingdom right here on earth for this assignment of taking the city. We will dedicate Birmingham to God. The City, Mayor and Police Commissioner need our help and God has equipped us to help. We will have to literally walk those streets like the 50's and 60's not so much as marching but now like Jesus and the apostles teaching, saving, healing, and converting. We are the "Acts Group" modern day demonstration of the acts of the Holy Spirit. God is much alive so where are our book of Acts. Holy Spirit is present to empower us for this mission.

- + (The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor; He has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom to the prisoners, and the recovery of sight to the blind, to liberate those who are abused and preach the year of the LORD'S favor.)
- Through Jesus we get a glimpse of our Rights in the Kingdom. No one in history ever demonstrated the love, power and authority we have as children of God or read to us our rights in the kingdom, as a matter of a fact we didn't have a clue that we even had any. How ignorant of us if we fight for our rights as citizens of our country but not citizens of our father's kingdom.



- + First things first, the Messianic message of Christ, which is, "Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand." Meaning, it is within reach and available to all of us. - + When the message of the kingdom is preached, it's really, divinely performing a spiritual DNA TEST to know who our father is. Truth is, we all have an eternal father and belong to a kingdom. There were originally one Kingdom, and it was torn and split by rebellion, pride, jealousy, selfishness and greed.



- No matter the race, creed, origin, gender or religion, we need to know and understand who our father is. Even if you don't know who your father is and may not have a relationship with him, don't leave this world and not know who your spiritual father is.
- When havoc broke out in heaven, God threw the hellraisers out of his kingdom and out of eternity into time on this earth. I believe according to God's word that time serves the purpose of separation of right and wrong, good and evil, life and death, love and hate, truth from lies in a temporal environment for us to ultimately return to our rightful place. Everyone has the right to be with their father and after this life, is judgment and God being just and the "Just Judge" will not separate anyone from their true father. Everything we all say and do is recorded and the day will come when we all will give an account for the way we lived our life.

We all have the right to know who our father is. No one should be a slave when they have been set free especially a slave to wrong doings. "If the Son sets you free, then you will be free indeed,"(John 8:36).
- + Kingdom Rights mission is to feed God's sheep and leave the goats and wolves for him to judge. Our focus is to anyone who is hungry and thirsty for what is right. We are a ministry made of broken, rejected, misunderstood, sinners who know and appreciate being saved by the love and grace of God. 

- + The 1950's and 1960's were horrific and challenging times to say the least. Dr King was not perpetrating running this movement without God privately or publicly. He made it clear that it was the power of God that was enable in them as a people to get this job done.
- + They were up against impossible circumstances, so they needed supernatural intervention, which came from God. The results of answered prayers were so evident and powerful that by 1962 the Supreme Court ruled prayer to be removed from public schools.

- + August 28, 1963, sixty years ago as of this year 2023, Dr. King would go on to make history with his unprecedented public speech of "I have a dream." God was the center of his message.
- + We need to have an annual public service on the last Sunday of the month of August, compelling us as a people to come back home to the Father. We must admit we are lost without God. We need to find a body of water to baptize anybody and everybody who feels the need to be baptized. We must preach a message of repentance.

- 4 When the time had come for the fulfillment of prophecy Jesus was born but baptism launched the movement. John was the forerunner of this movement. His messages were simple, "Repent." It was a public display of God calling humanity to repent. The announcement was "The kingdom of heaven is at hand" the condition was cleansed yourselves because the king is coming.
- + We must return to the message of "Repentance "for everyone to receive what God has for us as a people. This year 2023 marks 60 years ago Dr. Martin Luther King was jailed in Birmingham for his God given message. He was not ashamed of the gospel.



His message as like John the Baptist was to all who would hear and obey. It was not a private message behind closed doors. When people began to obey John's message the spirit of God made Jesus move from home to the Jordan to be baptized. When we preach this message publicly in the same city known for brutality and injustice, we will have the attention of all who are in need of **REVIVAL. THIS IS NOT ABOUT MONEY OR GREEDY LEADERS BUT GOD'S WILL AND THE SAVING OF A PEOPLE.** Our leaders who have preceded us in life, were our examples of how to submit to God faithfully fighting for what was right for his people.

+ America needs a REVIVAL! Money CANNOT buy a Revival or persuade Almighty God to visit us. This Kingdom Rights Movement, God is requiring a REPENTANT HEART! The right for God to dwell among His people.



We need to set the example of humility to reach the masses. God's eyes are on Birmingham! The city of Birmingham must be the birthplace of this **movement** and **revival!** When we go public to compel the world and church to participate in the movement of returning whole heartedly to God, the rest of the nation and world will hear. We must set the example of repentance and admit **we owe God an apology.**

With all due respect, based on the history of Birmingham seen around the world as the most segregated, hateful, and racist place demonstrated in this country, **do we think it's impossible to be known for the modern movement of love, restoration, and healing by way of Holy Ghost.**



- Have an annual public service on the last Sunday of the month of August. This should be the One Day the church building would be closed on a Sunday. This is where REVIVAL will breakout if we meet God with a godly sacrifice. We should sing, praise and worship God in spirit and in truth.
- We should reach out to as many men and women of God as possible for the historical event. Everything should be free on this day. We will not accept anything monetary at all, the only offering will be a "Repent" hearts and souls to the Lord. By this we will know that God is truly receiving the offerings of His people. We should fellowship, feed and have refreshments for everyone for free the entire day. Believing God for the impossible.



- Every, last Sunday of August, we would have an outdoor Service and Baptism at some large body of water and a place to accommodate the service. This will be in commemoration of Dr. King's "I Have a Dream" speech in Washington on August 28, 1963.
- Prayer Intercessors before, during and after the activity.
- Need to find a body of water for baptism and place to accommodate service and festivities for the people. It will be a great and glorious dedication to our God and His cause.
- Food, Beverages, Activities will be free.
- No monetary offering will be accepted, only the living sacrifices of repented hearts will be offered to God. We will strive to collect no money nor spend any on this day in honor of our God.



- Before and leading up to the activities we should explain baptism, a repentance heart, and our kingdom rights here on earth. Salvation should be our priority, turning the hearts of the people back to God. We are living in the last days and prioritizing saving lives is the mission. We could publicly display this on this day for the whole world to see, "There is a God" present in the city of Birmingham.
- Our purpose and goal is for people to see that we are servants of The Most High God by representing Jesus Christ, and reflecting how much we care for His sheep.
- That we have no hidden agendas. Having a day where we come from behind walls and publicly honor God by giving Him what He came and died for... His people. On this day we don't want MONEY to be a distraction or goal. In the Old Testament the "Burnt Offerings" were one of the most important offerings because there was no doubt as to who received the offering.



- Giving God the offerings of repentance will in no DOUBT demonstrate that on this day it's all about the will of God and giving Him souls.
- John saw a number in which no man could number. But we also are required to help reach that number of souls to present to God. We are so accustomed to the anointing but oftentimes we need to see the GLORY.
- I believe by doing this we will witness God's Glory. Let's give God the offering He deserves, especially on this day. I believe that the kingdom will be, "at hand, among us and in us" on this day. Let the world see that we as disciples of Jesus Christ are serious about reaching, teaching, and changing the minds of a damaged and lost society.



- Our message is simply what John the Baptist message was, "REPENT" because the Kingdom of God is available." We must compel the people to change their minds and change how they think. This was our pastor's message. We, the sons, and daughters who are the recipients of the sacrifices made by those who have preceded us are responsible for carrying the message of keeping the legacy intact.
- When we leave this world and join our spiritual family, all that will matter, is did we continue the work and do God's will.
