- Q. How did you get involved with NEHI?
- A Having led a number of housing projects, a friend referred me to the NEHI search committee because I had expressed a desire to work in a community close to home. For years I had worked in communities across the US and now I wanted to live in the results of my work.
- Q. Why is NEHI's mission important to you?
- ${\mathbb A}$ I believe housing is a fundamental right, and not a privilege. Housing is the foundation to a successful life. It's hard to focus on anything else without adequate housing.
- Q. Where do you see NEHI five years from now? A. In five years, I see NEHI as a major housing provider in Maryland, changing the rules for permanently affordable housing.
- Q. As a native of South Carolina, what similarities have you found between Baltimore and the south?
- A Similarities would be good food and good people. Everywhere I go, I meet good people in Baltimore.

This month, NEHI's Stewardship events have been quite a success! On Saturday, April 16th, NEHI in partnership with NE Leaders, Code in the Schools. Smalltimore Homes. and Community Organization, held a digital literacy technology workshop located at Mr. Dwayne Richardson's community lot, located in Belair-Edison. This was a follow-up to the March workshop held at the Belair-Edison Schools. These workshops were designed to provide information on digital inequities, digital literacy & access, and technology assistance for local community members. Our thanks to the NE Leaders for organizing the events and to the Deutsch Foundation for funding the initiatives.

On Monday, April 25th, volunteers went door to door in the 4x4, talking to residents about trash literacy. The goal was to help educate residents on the effects of trash, proper disposal of trash, the difference between trash & recycling, trash & recycling pickup days, and bringing awareness to the connection between trash and rats.
