

WHAT IS CRISIS INTERVENTION COUNSELING?

Immediate, Short-Term Support

Crisis Intervention Counseling is a form of short-term counseling designed to provide immediate emotional support and problemsolving assistance to individuals experiencing crisis in family matters, marriage, finances, or mental health.

The primary goal is to stabilize the individual, reduce distress, and help them regain a sense of control while providing practical tools for managing the crisis, reinforcing resilience, and connecting clients with longer-term support if needed.

Bridging Gaps in Care

In partnership with your church/ministry, based upon you needs, we will

- *Training Development:* Develop a training program for lay counselors combining spiritual care and psychological practices.
- **Resource Accessibility:** Build a resource network for continuous counselor support.
- **Community Outreach:** Raise awareness about the availability of mental health support at your church with an aim to reduce stigma and foster understanding.
- Partnership Building: Partner with professional mental health organizations and other faith communities to enhance their support system
- *Monitoring and Evaluation:* Establish a system to assess and improve counseling services.



Family Crisis Impacts the Church


Research shows that a significant percentage of people in crisis seek help from their faith communities. According to studies from the American Psychiatric Association and other mental health organizations, 25% to 40% of individuals facing mental health issues or personal crises turn to clergy or religious leaders before seeking professional mental health care.

Recent statistics reveal that a significant number of churches are unprepared to address family crisis situations, such as grief, marriage issues, and financial struggles within their communities. For instance, studies indicate that 72% of U.S. churches lack a substantive ministry to support marriages

Studies also show that churches are underprepared to handle mental health crises, with only 27% having a plan in place to support affected families.

- Choose a Location
- Secure Funding
- Obtain Licenses and Permits/Insurance
