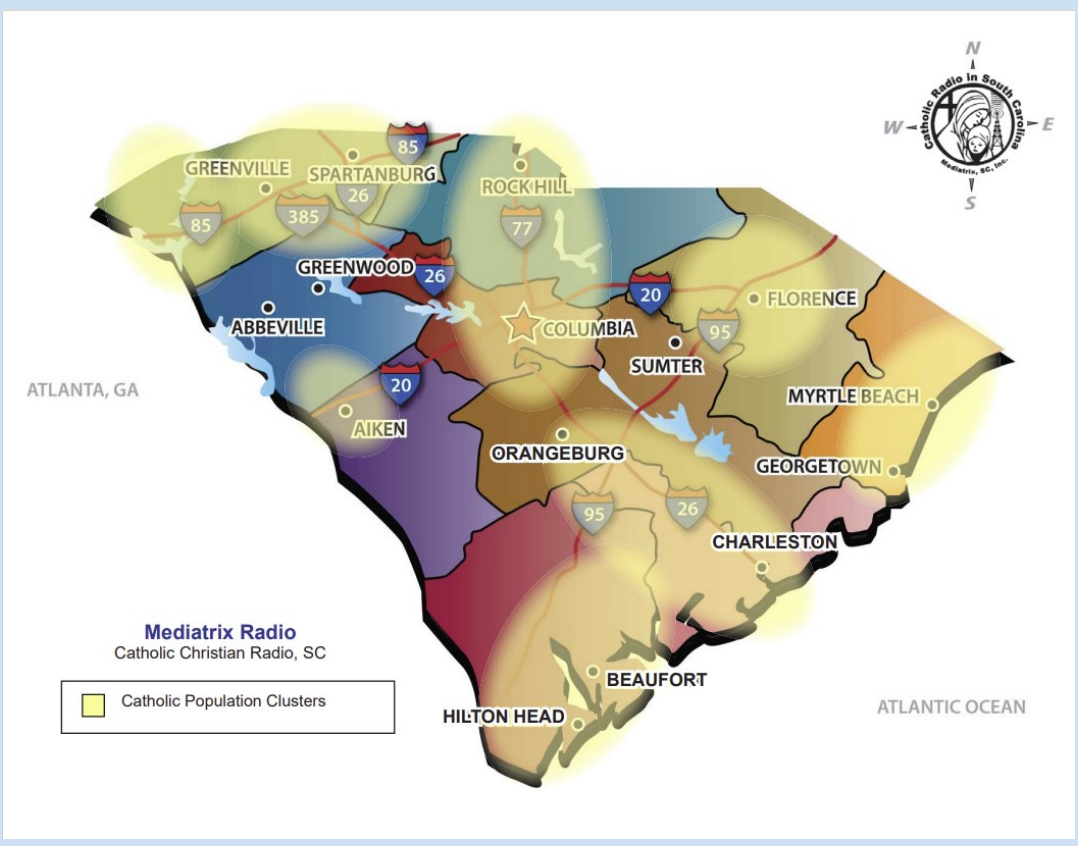

The more we welcome our Lord to rule as king of our hearts and our homes, the more our nation will grow and flourish.

Brother Knights, while you prepare to undertake your convention deliberations, I ask that you seek more fervently the intercession of Blessed Michael McGivney, as you join Knights across the world in praying for his canonization. Thank you and *Vivat Jesus!*

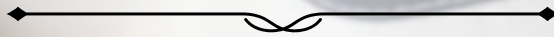

Our council is the first Knights of Columbus council in the two Carolinas. Our formation was in 1902. The following year, in 1903, the first class of new candidates was initiated on May 20<sup>h</sup> in Hibernian Hall. A total of 20 men became Knights. In 1906 the Council began construction on the present hall on Calhoun Street. Our namesake is the Most Reverend P.N. Lynch, Third Bishop of Charleston –1858 - 1882

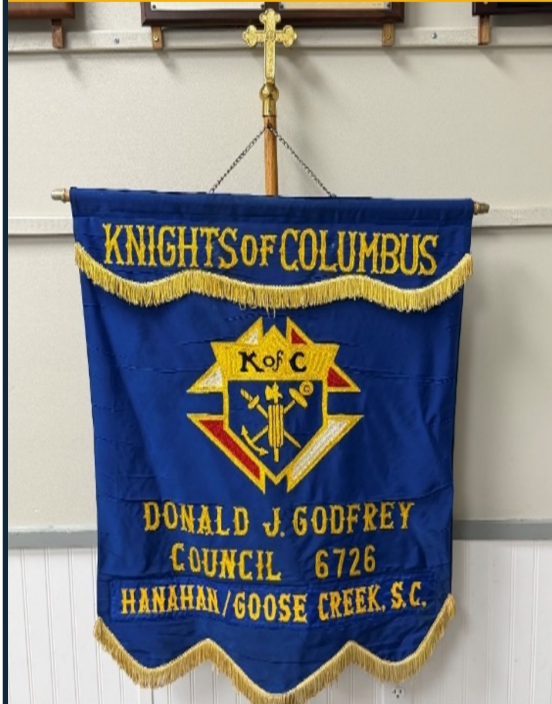
