According to the Wayne State University Center for Behavioral Health and Justice, "Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) is a court-ordered program designed for individuals with serious mental illness who need ongoing support but may not voluntarily seek or comply with treatment." All three of the distinguished panelists will discuss AOT from the point of view of each person's experience: Judge Mack as a long-time Probate Court Judge; Julia Stewart as a researcher at Wayne State University and Jessica Martin as a social worker embedded in the Lansing Police Department.
