Cleaver was ordained an Itinerant Elder in the African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church. He is an endorsed chaplain by the AME Church and a member of the Henry McNeal Turner Chaplain's Association

Rev. Cleaver currently serves on the Whole Health Steering Committee at the Atlanta VA Medical Center. He presented on Mind, Body, and Spirit Self-care Practices for the Payne Theological Seminary's Ministers Retreat. Rev. Cleaver most recently presented on Preaching and Chaplaincy: Wider Fields of Service at The Power of a Thinking Church Scholars and Practitioners Conference for the AME Church.

Reverend Alvelyn Sanders-Swafford, a native of Atlanta, Georgia, has worked extensively in media/film, the arts, ministry, and politics. She and her husband, Reverend Raymond Swafford, serve as Co-Pastors of Gaines Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church in Phenix City, Alabama in the Ninth Episcopal District of the AME Church. She is the author of Lord, Have Mercy: 5 Go-To Prayers When You Need To Pray, But Don't Know What To Say. Sanders-Swafford is a graduate of Northwestern University (B.S., Radio-TV-Film), Clark Atlanta University (M.A., African American Studies), and the Candler School of Theology at Emory University (Master of Theological Studies; Master of Divinity), with additional study in London, England at the City of London Polytechnic while at Northwestern. Sanders-Swafford received a 2022 President Joseph R. Biden Lifetime Achievement and Volunteer Service Award for her work in the media – telling the story of the "foot soldiers" of the Atlanta Student Movement in her award-winning film documentary, "Foot Soldiers: Class of 1964," which has been broadcast on PBS stations – gratefully. She served as a longtime reporter for WABE 90.1 FM, Atlanta's NPR station, and her work has been published in Essence magazine, Black Issues Book Review, Northwestern (University) and The Atlanta Journal-Constitution.

Sanders-Swafford was licensed to preach in the AME Church in 2004, ordained as an Itinerant Deacon in 2007, and an Itinerant Elder in 2009, both in the Atlanta North Georgia Annual Conference in the Sixth Episcopal District by the late Bishop William Phillips DeVeaux, Sr. at her "home church," Big Bethel AME Church on Auburn Avenue in Atlanta, Georgia. At Big Bethel, Sanders-Swafford journeyed by God's grace from the pew to the pulpit. During her time at Big Bethel, as a Steward and later as an Assistant Minister, she was blessed to serve under the following pastors: Bishop James L. Davis, the Reverend Dr. Mark Thompson, the now newly elected Bishop Gregory V. Eason, Sr., and the present pastor, the Reverend Dr. John Foster – providing leadership for numerous ministries at the local church and Presiding Elder district levels. She is the daughter of Dr. Georgianne Thomas, Trustee Emeritus at Big Bethel AME Church, and a noted scholar, filmmaker, and Civil Rights activist.

In addition to Gaines Chapel, since 2014, Sanders-Swafford has served as a pastor at the following churches: New Magnolia AME Church, Bessemer, AL; Greater St. Paul AME Church, Florence, AL; and St. James AME Church – Avondale in Birmingham, AL. As a pastor, she focuses on the spiritual growth of the congregation and the community at-large by emphasizing the gift of prayer, preaching on the promises of God, and encouraging God's people to live their best God-ordained life through Jesus Christ. Additionally, she believes the Church should be a leader in community outreach and civic engagement – using her skills in and passion for both areas as she serves. Finally, she's been blessed to share her background as a communications professional with the churches she's served. Sanders-Swafford serves as the Dean of the Board of Examiners of the Ninth Episcopal District. She counts it an honor and privilege to assist new ministers on their journey.

Sanders-Swafford has had the distinction of serving on the administrative staff of the Ninth Episcopal District, under the leadership of Bishop James L. Davis, Bishop Harry L. Seawright, and now Bishop Julius Harrison McAllister, Jr. Also, she had the privilege of serving, by invitation, on the staff of Bishop Jeffery B. Cooper, the immediate past General Secretary/Chief Information Officer of the AME Church, for AME connectional meetings from 2016 – 2024.

Reverend Alvelyn Sanders-Swafford is a member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. She is grateful for her family, village, mentors, and the kindness of friends and strangers. She is grateful for God's love, grace, and mercy, and she prays to lead a life and ministry pleasing to God.
