

What Is the CDMDC aka DMC?

The Christian Debutante-Master Dedication Commission (CDMDC) is a group of adults, who reinforce the work of Christian education by providing guidance and information in the context of relevant study and fieldwork activities. (generally called DMC).

Youth participating in the DMC have an opportunity to receive regular and special study programs for personal Christian development and creative leadership in the A.M.E. Church. Adult participation consists of teaching and training youth in prescribed areas mentioned above and later in this document.

The A.M.E. Debutante-Master Dedication Ceremony allows young people, ages five to eighteen to celebrate their Christian journey. Graduating Seniors are celebrated as the Debutantes and Masters completing their youthful Christian journey to begin their adult experience. Youth are introduced, in a rite of passage to the church society and to dedicate their lives to further or greater Christian service.




