



It is with great pleasure that we make our 11th Annual Report as Senior Pastor of the Historic Big Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church, 220 Auburn Avenue NE, Atlanta, GA. God continues to raise us to new heights as we proclaim that "JESUS SAVES."

During this past conference year, the Big Bethel Family was blessed in many areas. Please allow me to share a few highlights from our extraordinary year:

Multi-Media Community Outreach via 175/185 Billboard and Auburn Avenue/Jesse Hill Marquee: As a result of our relationship with Outfront Advertising, Big Bethel received a public service announcement advertisement on the 175/185 Corridor - "The Connector" – the 4th busiest interchange in the United States of America. Our billboard message is seen by over 300,000 commuters daily. In addition, Big Bethel has a state-of-the-art digital marquee installed and operational on the corner of Auburn Avenue and Jesse Hill Drive. Over 14,000 persons view our marquee daily. The combination of the billboard and marquee announces the message of "JESUS SAVES" to the downtown Atlanta Community.

Our Social Action Ministry had a banner year with our Martin Luther King, Jr. and Marcus Garvey Annual Days. Big Bethel was blessed with the speakers of District Attorney Fani Willis and the Marcus Garvey commemoratory service day. We received national and international recognition for each of these days. May God continue to bless the mission of Bishop Reginald Jackson and our church in being a prophetic voice of our community.

Big Bethel's success in receiving Externally Funded Community Development Church Grants and Projects including the Church Restoration and Millenial Grants. As part of the Preserving Black Churches grants, the National Trust's African American Cultural Heritage Action Fund provides \$4M in funding to further protect the institutional legacy of America to 31 historic Black churches across the U.S. FOR THE NEXT 50 YEARS!!! In addition, the BRIDGE Innovation Hub will convene its cohort of congregational teams to learn, develop, test, and implement new approaches to ministry alongside young adults in the metropolitan Atlanta area.
