Dead Roots, Dead Trees

Colossians 2:7 (CEV)

Plant your roots in Christ and let him be the foundation for your life. Be strong in your faith, just as you were taught. And be grateful.

One of my favorite theme songs in the Big Bethel's renowned play, "Heaven Bound" is the song, "I Shall not Be moved"...to me, the important message in the you are the words, "Like a tree planted by the water..." The implication is that trees with roots that are watered are strong. They are healthy; they are grounded. That is why when a wind comes by, these roots do not allow their trees to fall. When heavy rains come, their trees do not tilt over and die. But, when the roots are no longer watered, they weaken, and when they weaken, so do the trees.

We are the Trees

In the vineyard, we are God's trees. We are God's workers. God looks to us to keep the church alive. We have the obligation, too, to keep our community alive. We do that by "watering" our roots.

How do we water our roots? I believe Paul gave us the answer in his letter to the church at Colossae. We plant our faith in our foundation, Christ Jesus! Another famous him tells us, "The church's One Foundation is Jesus Christ, her Lord; she is His new creation by water and the word!" By planting our faith in Jesus and not in the world, we can withstand whatever the world sends our way. This includes social ills, political crises, economic hardship and personal challenges. As a people, we must use our faith to maintain ourselves as powerful "trees" that protect and guard the truth.

Our work on behalf of marginalized populations, our fight to resist voter apathy and oppression, our future hopes to elect the first Black woman as President of these United States and our commitment to equal rights, are all made viable when we keep our roots watered and strong.

The system allows the subscriber to receive notifications based on an individual's name or property address. Once registered, you will then receive notifications anytime that name or address is mentioned on a real-estate filing.
