#### THE CALL TO WORSHIP

Minister: O God, you have heard the anguished cries of our ancestors. Their sounds echo and penetrate time to remind us of our fore parents who were brutally captured and forcibly enslaved, as they left the peaceful womb of their African homeland.

People: "Stony the road we trod."

Minister: O God, you have seen the millions of dark bodies buried beneath the tumultuous waves of the deep. Bodies of African men and women who held the seeds of greatness. You have seen women's dreams for a united family vanish as they were sold at auction blocks. You have seen the legacy of the African Ameri can family decimated and demeaned by those who have attempted to control our destiny.

People: "Bitter the chastening rod, felt in the days when hope unborn had died."

Minister: O God, you have ignited the sparks within us into a blazing demand for freedom, equality and justice. This guest cost Harriet Tubman sleepless nights, as she led her people to freedom; it was an equality that Rosa Parks and civil rights activists fought for and gave their lives for; it was a justice that Martin Luther King, Jr. for, as thousands stood with him at the Lincoln Memorial.

People: "Yet with a steady beat, have not our weary feet, come to the place for which our fathers sighted?"

Minister: O God, you have seen our tears. You have been pained by the evil of human hearts. Yet, you loved humanity enough that you sent your only son to identify with the outcast, marginalized and rejected. As the cries of Jesus pierced your heart, so have the cries of your people - cries from different cultures and in different languages.

People: "God of our weary years, God of our silent tears."

Minister: O God, you answered us during our exodus from Africa. You wiped every teardrop during our exile in captivity. Our fore parents dared to dream that one day, on these shores, we would become politicians, preachers, educators, doctors, writers, scientists, artists, and so much more.

People: "Lest our feet stray from the places, our God, where we met Thee."

Minister: Our ancestors' hard work, their courage, their convictions, and their belief in you paved the way for our emancipation and education. But it is clear, you have liberated us. You have set us free. "Free at last, free at last, thank God Almighty, I'm free at last!"

ALL: "Lest our hearts drunk with the wine of the world we forget Thee. Shadowed beneath Thy hand, may we forever stand. True to our God and true to our native land."

## Rev. Han Hale Wicker

Alan Hale Wicker was born to the parentage of Jessie Leon Wicker and Thelma Elizabeth Bianca Hale (Wicker). His elementary and secondary education took place in the Orleans Parish Schools, New Orleans, Louisiana. He graduated from Grambling State University, (B.S. in Instrumental Music Education, 1974). He acknowledged his call to preach, at age 12 and later was licensed to Preach in 1974 at Saint James AMEC, New Orleans. His Parish Ministry began in Sun,

Louisiana (1974) and continued in Louisiana, Mississippi, and Georgia, until 2001 where he was elevated to the office of Presiding Elder from Wesley Chapel AMEC.

He has been the pastor of Zion Chapel, Sun, LA., Union Chapel, Kentwood, LA., Saint Matthew, Greenville, MS., The Hogansville Circuit, (Hogansville and LaGrange, Georgia), Flipper Chapel, Milledgeville, GA., Saint Luke, Macon, GA., Greater Allen Chapel, Macon, GA., Gray Chapel, Macon, Georgia, and Wesley Chapel, Milledgeville, GA.

His Ministry as Presiding Elder began on the defunct Southern District in the Southwest Georgia Annual Conference and continued on the obsolete Macon District, the Macon Georgia Annual Conference, and now he supplies as the Retired Presiding Elder of the Macon East District in the Macon Georgia Annual Conference. He is a M.Div. graduate of Turner Theological Seminary (1981) at the Interdenominational Theological Center. He completed 1 Basic Quarter of Clinical Pastoral Education at Georgia Retardation Center in Atlanta, GA., 4 quarters of Advanced Clinical Pastoral Education at Georgia Mental Health Institute in Atlanta Georgia. Subsequently he worked as a Clinical Chaplain at Central State Hospital in Milledgeville, Georgia for 10 years from 1982 to 1992. He completed 6 quarters of Supervisory Clinical Pastoral Education at Central State Hospital in Milledgeville, Georgia. He is also a graduate of Mercer University in Macon Georgia with a M.S. degree in Marriage and Family Studies.

He is the husband of the Reverend Gloria J. Wicker, Ed.D. and together they have four adult children and 8 grandchildren (6 biological and 2 step). His favorite scripture is "But Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto thee" (Matthew 6:33). He is a retired presiding elder (June 2022) after 48 years of ministry.

In November of 2021 he was elected as a Trustee for Georgia Military College. His world view is: I am activating God's presence in my life when I love someone. 




