Reverend Maurice Wright, II

On September 13, 2016 The Reverend Maurice Wright, II was appointed by the Right Reverend Harry L. Seawright to serve as the Senior Pastor of the Historic St. John AME Church Huntsville, Alabama. His assignment was the first of the Episcopal Ministry of the newly elected Bishop.

He is a native of the Pacific Northwest, having grown up in Tacoma Washington and Portland Oregon. Reverend Wright dedicated his life to Christ at a very young age and was called into ministry at the age of 10. He preached his very first sermon, "You Got What You Wanted, But Lost What You Had" at the age of 13 at the Powerhouse Temple Church of God in Christ.

Reverend Wright is a graduate of Grover Cleveland High School in Portland Oregon. His thirst for knowledge would lead him to study at Portland Bible College and Wilberforce University in Ohio. He is a proud graduate of Morehouse College, Atlanta Georgia earning a degree in the area of Choral Conducting and Vocal Performance. While at Morehouse Reverend Wright was a key member of the World Renowned Morehouse College Glee Club, and was part of the group that toured South Africa. He was also a member of the Martin Luther King Jr, Chapel Assistants and the director of the Chapel Choir. While in Atlanta Georgia, he served on the ministerial staff and was the Minister of Music at Big Bethel AME Church. Reverend Wright was recently admitted to the Master's program in Interfaith Action at the Claremont Lincoln University in Claremont, California.

In 2012 Reverend Wright received King Chapel's highest recognition and was inducted into The Morehouse College Martin Luther King Jr. International College of Ministers and Laity.

He has served as pastor of St. John AME Church in Ft. Mitchell, Alabama, Bethel AME Church in Alexandria, Louisiana, St. John AME Church in Uhrichsville, Ohio and the Historic St. Paul AME Church in Zanesville, Ohio.

In addition to his pastorate, Reverend Wright currently serves as the Associate Director of Music and Christian Arts of the African Methodist Episcopal Church worldwide. He is also the co-director of Evangelism for the state of Alabama. Rev. Wright is a sought after preacher and choir clinician.

Reverend Wright is truly a family man, he is blessed to have the Reverend Joretha Wright as his partner in marriage and ministry for 20 years. They are the proud parents of four children Terrence, Lessie, Isaiah and Joy.



Withdrawal from social and work activities



PLANNING

Trouble problem solving and planning and doing familiar tasks like tracking monthly bills



TIME

Confusion with time or place; Losing track of dates or seasons



LANGUAGE

Trouble following conversations or finding the word; calling things the wrong name



MOOD

Beyond confused, depressed, or anxious, easily upset or lashing out at others




