Juneteenth commemorates the emancipation of Black American slaves. The holiday originated in Galveston, Texas, and it has been celebrated annually on June 19 in various parts of the United States since 1865. The day is particularly significant because unbeknownst to Blacks in Galveston, emancipation had already taken place more than 2 years before when 2,000 Union troops arrived in Galveston announcing they were free. Also known in some circles as Black Independence Day, President Biden signed the celebration as a federal holiday into legislation in 2021.
