



Make sure legal documents are in order.





AME Church Full Tuition Student Scholarship \$8500 per year

Scholarship applicant must:

- be high school graduating senior, transfer student or currently enrolled at Morris Brown College who is a member of the AME Church (includes male and female students)
- have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) and submit an official school transcript; the transcript must cite the applicant's cumulative grade point average
- · must maintain a minimum of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) while attending Morris Brown at the end of each semester
- · submit a typed essay.

Topic: Based on financial need, describe how winning this scholarship would impact your future plans.

- · submit (1) signed letter of recommendation from school (teacher–former or present, counselors, principals, professors, etc.)
- · submit (1) letter of recommendation from the student's local AME church
- · submit (1) signed letter of recommendation from a representative of a non-school related community service or organization that the applicant participated in; letter must be on the organization's letterhead; persons writing letter of recommendation should specify relationship or capacity in which they know or have observed the applicant and SIGN the letter
