
Charis Jude Egges





Brenda plans to attend Columbus State University this Fall and major in *Elementary* Education.








Linda is a 2023 graduate of Kipp Atlanta Collegiate High School where she was section leader of the trombone section of her school Band. It was there she developed strong leadership,


