After graduating from San Diego State, 2014. She completed her theological education at The Interdenominational Theological Center (ITC), with a concentration in Psychology of Pastoral Care, where she graduated in May of 2018. Later she completed a residency at The Atlanta Veterans Hospital (2018-2019), and she is currently an employee of Select Medical as an Account Manager. Currently, a member of St. Paul AME Covington where she is the youth and young adult pastor.


Before moving to Atlanta, Georgia, Jessica was a part of the NAACP, San Diego Chapter, the Urban League Young Professionals, and she was former Vice President of Turner Theological Seminary on the campus of ITC. Wilkes Memorial Award" and "The Bishop Donald George Kenneth Ming Award," for denominational academic excellence; and later she was selected and inducted into the Honor Society, Theta Phi. In addition, she was selected to be a part of RISE (Renew; Inspire; Support; Empower) as a Mentee for the RISE Together National Mentorship Network Class of 2020. In May of 2018, Rev. Buford, graduated Cum Laude from ITC, by way of Turner Theological Seminary. She was ordained an Iterate Deacon in October of 2018, and later ordained and Itinerate Elder in 2019 in the fifth episcopal district of the AMEC.

She counts it a joy to be a servant of God. One of her favorite scriptures is Isaiah 54:17, "No weapon that is fashioned against you shall prosper, and you shall confute every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord and their vindication from me, says the Lord."
