Interfaith Children's Sabbath 2024 Speakers



Sis. Shahidah Sharif (Islam)

For the past 20 years, Sister Shahidah Sharif has lived her passion and her purpose as an international servant leader, educator, scholar, entrepreneur, certified doula, speaker, and non- profit strategist. Currently serving as the Communications Director for the Atlanta Masjid of Al- Islam, Shahidah has served the Atlanta community for the past 15 years. Children, women and families have guided her work. She also serves as the Board President for Sisters United In Human Service. As a linguist, Arabic Instructor, Islamic Studies teacher, curriculum writer and professional development facilitator, Shahidah has provided services to the Sister Clara Mohammed Schools System in Atlanta and Hajja's House Global Learning Center. Shahidah is an instructor without borders. Her professional acumen and pedagogical skills have taken her to teach in Central America, North America, South Africa, the Middle East and beyond.

She is the owner and co-founder of Hajj Pro's (Professional Hajj and Umrah Guides), and since its founding in 2004 has taken over 25 delegations, and escorted many believers to the Holy City of Makkah. Hajj Pro's has also taken youth delegations for both spiritual obligations, and academic exploration o ering student abroad opportunities. She has also traveled with and led an interfaith journey with World Pilgrims of Atlanta to Arizona and Guatemala.

Shahidah Sharif attended the University of Miami and the Mosque Cares study program at the Abu Nour University in Damascus, Syria for a 3 year intensive for Arabic language, Islamic Sciences and D'awah, or ministry. A novice gardener, runner, and seasoned traveler who always welcomes a good cup of co □ee and conversation. Shahidah lives in Atlanta with her husband and business partner, and two brilliant children.



Mr. Brendan Murphy (Catholic-Christianity)

An award-winning educator and a sought-after presenter on religious solidarity, Mr. Brendan Murphy serves as the founding director of the Bearing Witness Institute for Interreligious and Ecumenical Dialogue at Marist School. Brendan has taught history at Marist School since 1994 and has been recognized with the Outstanding Educator Award from the Anne Frank Center in New York; the ADL's Abe Goldstein Human Relations and Unsung Hero Awards; Marist School's Goizueta Chair of Excellence Award, Faber-McKinley-Stadler Award, and Frank P. Hagan Memorial Coach's Award; the Distinguished Service Award from the Georgia Independent School Association; the Educator of the Year by the University of Notre Dame; and, in 2009 and 2016, the Georgia Outstanding Educator of the Year by the Georgia Commission on the Holocaust. Brendan is a Museum Teacher Fellow at the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum in Washington, D.C. and a Lerner Fellow at the Jewish Foundation for the Righteous in New York. Recently, he was selected as a member of the Leadership Atlanta Class of 2025.




