Rev. Kelvin Johnson

Rev. Kelvin Johnson was born in Grenada, Mississippi. He is the youngest of six born to Bennie and Annie Mae Johnson. Raised in a Baptist Church, where his father was a deacon and his mother taught Sunday School, worked in the Women's guild, and sang in the adult choir. At the age of 9, his family moved to Milwaukee, WI. Kelvin graduated from Rufus King International Baccalaureate High School. After graduating, he enlisted

in the Air Force. He began working in an Air Force hospital as a Cardiopulmonary Technologist. While in the Air Force, he was selected 58th Air Group Hospital Airman of the Month, 58th Air Group Hospital Airman of the Quarter, 58th Air Group Base Airman of the Quarter, and the 58th Air Group Hospital Airman of the Year, as well as a Distinguished Graduate of Non-Commissioned Officer School. After separating from the Air Force, Kelvin returned to Milwaukee and began working for a local hospital. In 2000, he began working for the Milwaukee Fire Department as a firefighter and paramedic and was selected as the 2006 paramedic of the year.

In 2006, Kelvin and his family relocated to the Atlanta area. In 2009, he joined the DeKalb County Fire Rescue Department as a firefighter and paramedic. He was selected 2013 paramedic of the year. He also accepted his call to preach. He enrolled in nursing school. After completing nursing school, he worked for DeKalb Medical Center and was selected as the Emergency Department nurse of the year for two consecutive years. He was promoted to Emergency Department charge nurse and also worked as a relief House Supervisor. Feeling the need to learn more and do more for his patients, Kelvin moved to Grady. At Grady, he blossomed into Emergency Department charge nurse, promoted to clinical educator, and promoted clinical manager.

Currently, Rev. Johnson is employed at Grady Health System as a Nursing Administrator. Additionally, he works for Georgia State University as a clinical site instructor. He is enrolled full-time at Payne Theological Seminary and is expected to graduate in May 2024. He is in fourth year holding in the North Atlanta Board of Examiners. His favorite scripture is Romans 8:28, "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love GOD, to them who are the called according to his purpose."

Rev. Johnson is a member of Macedonia AME Church in Rex, pastored by Rev. Cornelius B. Scott, where he teaches bible study, is on the wellness committee and works with the Young Adult Missionary Society.

He is married to Tracey Johnson; they have been married for 28 years. They are the proud parents of four children: Christopher 31, Julian 28, Nicholas 26, and Lauryn 24. He is especially proud that all four children are college graduates.

By working together, we can provide opportunities for all those affected to access care and support services, engage in research and advance advocacy. *Purple Sunday* is designed to educate members of the faith community about Alzheimer's and other dementias. Members will learn about the impact of Alzheimer's disease in our community, how to recognize the signs of Alzheimer's, the importance of early detection, and how to access care and support resources.

Facts About Alzheimer's

- » More than 6 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's disease, and over 11 million serve as unpaid caregivers.
- » 1 in 3 seniors dies with Alzheimer's or another dementia. It kills more than breast cancer and prostate cancer combined.
- » Almost two-thirds of Americans with Alzheimer's disease are women.
- » African Americans are twice as likely to develop Alzheimer's disease as older White Americans.
- » Genetic and environmental factors may work differently to cause Alzheimer's disease in African-Americans.
- » African-Americans tend to be diagnosed at a later stage of Alzheimer's disease-limiting the effectiveness of treatments that depend upon early intervention.
