Hunt Wild Hogs

Cost: \$500 per man

- Cost includes:
- Hunting from baited stands on over 1600 acres
- 4 days/3 nights lodging
- Meals and Snacks included
- Insurance
- Open to Men ages 18 and older

DETAILS

- Our hunts will be guided by the volunteers of Ironman Outdoors.
- This means each guest will be taken to their stands prior to each hunt and each guest will be picked up at their stand at the end of each hunt.
- Stands will have feeders or corn piles with treestands or box blinds positioned nearby.
- **NEVER leave your stand at any time during a hunt.**
- This means there will be no stalking and no tracking of any animals without a guide present.

DETAILS

- We will have a place to skin and clean animals that we harvest but we suggest that you bring a large cooler to transport them home.
- Prior to allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to sign a liability waiver and show a Valid Hunting License for the state of AL.

DETAILS

- During the retreat we will also conduct a “Hogzilla” contest. Largest hog gets a prize!!
- Meals and snacks will be provided. There will be snacks that you can take with you in the stand.
- Please **DO NOT** leave trash on (or in) the stands.
- No cleaning fees or tips required.

DETAILS

- No limit on hogs. We will draw numbers for stands.
- If you violate a game law, you will be asked to leave the retreat without refund.
- We will hunt after dark from stands each night. Please bring a decent green or red hunting light that can project 100 yards for night hunting.
- Night Vision/thermal optics are allowed and encouraged. We also have green lights mounted on feeders.

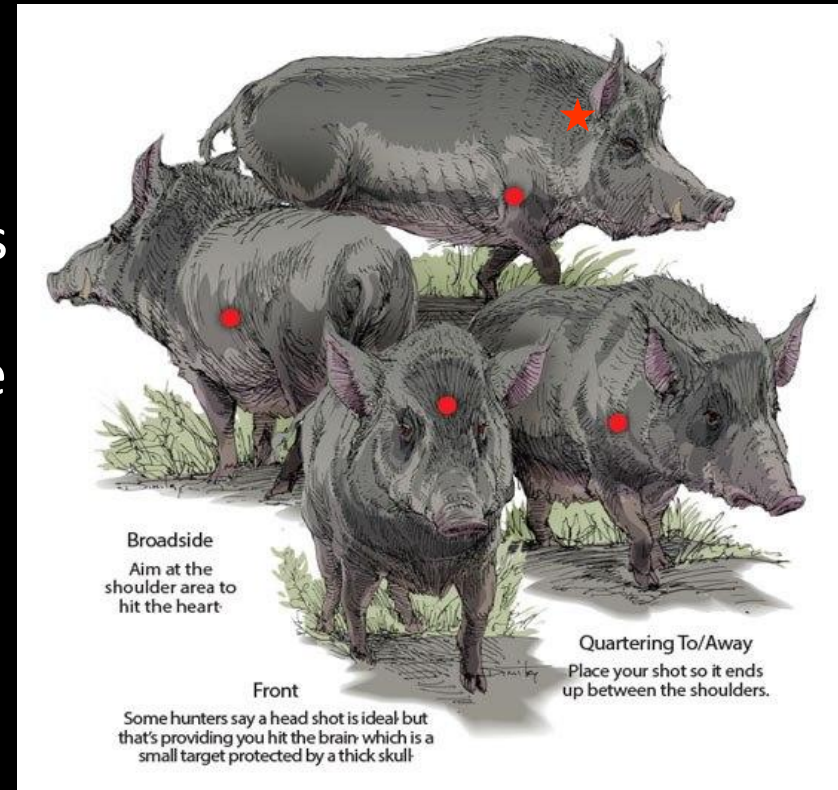

TAKING YOUR SHOT

Hogs often grow a “plate” over the front quarter of their body that makes effective heart and lung shots difficult.

- Head shots to the ear with a large caliber rifle are the preferred method of harvest.
- Shotguns are not recommended





MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS

- During our four days together, we will gather as a group to conduct our “Manhood Discussions”
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, fatherhood, and women to leadership, sports, and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They’re Not Devotions and They’re Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully expected to be present for these discussions.



Packing Lists

-Valid AL Hunting Licenses:

- 1) 3-day small game
- 2) Bait Privilege
- 3) Nighttime Feral Swine

-Gun/Gun Case

ALL Guns MUST be transported unloaded and stored in cases

-Hunter Orange Vest or Hat

-Towel / Soap

-Pillow/Blanket/Bed linens

-Red/Green hunting light

-Tree stand Safety Harness

SUGGESTED

-Snake boots are strongly suggested

-Rain/snow/cold weather Gear

-Camera

-Binoculars

-Cooler to transport harvest

-Night Vision optics

-Cushion to sit on – in stand

-Extra batteries for your light

-No alcohol allowed

Our Policy:

REFUNDS

- We can allow refunds if given 30 days notice before the retreat. We will subtract 3% if fees were paid with a card.
- No refunds within 30 days of the retreat.
- A deposit (usually 50% of hunt cost) is required upon booking a retreat. No retreat will be considered booked until Ironman Outdoors receives a deposit.
