
# Alabama Hog Hunt

For out of state residents, please purchase these 3 items.



- Our hunts will be guided by the volunteers of Ironman Outdoors.
- This means each guest will be taken to their stands prior to each hunt and each guest will be picked up at their stand at the end of each hunt.
- Stands will have feeders or corn piles with treestands positioned nearby.
- NEVER leave your stand at any time during a hunt.
- This means there will be no stalking and no tracking of any animals without a guide present.



- We will have a place to skin and clean animals that we harvest but we suggest that you bring a large cooler to transport them home.
- Prior to allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to sign a liability waiver and a show a Valid Hunting License for the state of AL.





- During the retreat we will also conduct a "Hogzilla" contest. Largest hog gets a prize!!
- Meals and snacks will be provided. There will be snacks that you can take with you in the treestand.
- Please DO NOT leave trash on (or in) the stands.

• If you have never cleaned a hog, we can assist you cleaning your

hog.





- No limit on hogs. We will draw numbers for stands.
- If you violate a game law, you will be asked to leave the retreat without refund.
- We have NO bow stands, so bring your best deer rifle with scope.
- We will hunt after dark from stands each night. Please bring a decent green or red hunting light that can project 100 yards for night hunting. Night Vision/thermal optics are allowed and encouraged.
- **READ THIS:** we have lights mounted on the feeders, however sometimes the hog is not standing under the feeder, please bring your own green or red light to be able to shoot a hog if he's not under the feeder.



#### **TAKING YOUR SHOT**

Hogs often grow a "plate" over the front quarter of their body that makes effective heart and lung shots difficult.

- Head shots to the ear with a large caliber rifle are the preferred method of harvest.
- Shotguns are not recommended







#### **MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS**

- During our three days together, we will gather as a group to conduct our "Manhood Discussions"
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, fatherhood and women to leadership, sports and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They're Not Devotions and They're Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully asked to be present

#### **MANDATORY**

- Valid AL Hunting Licenses
- Gun/Gun Case
  - **ALL** Guns **MUST** be transported unloaded and stored in cases
- Hunter Orange Vest or Hat
- Towel / Soap
- Pillow/Blanket/Bed linens
- Red/Green hunting light
- Treestand Safety Harness

#### **SUGGESTED**

- Snake boots are strongly suggested
- Rain/snow/cold weather Gear
- Camera
- Binoculars
- Cooler to transport harvest
- Night Vision optics
- Cushion to sit on in stand
- Extra batteries for your light
- No alcohol allowed
