Hunt Deer and Hogs

December 14-16, 2023

Cost: \$825 per person

- Cost includes hunting hogs and deer
- Hunting on private property
- 2 nights lodging

Welcome to Ironman Outdoors

This is a high end deer and hog hunt that will take place on private property in the famous Lowcountry of South Carolina

Each hunter will be allowed to harvest 1 buck 12” or bigger and either 1 doe or 1 hog (maximum of 2 animals). **One animal per hunt. There will be a \$400 fine for violation of these rules.**

The outfitter offers a 1st class 4 bedroom, 5 bath lodge that can accommodate up to 12 hunters.



DETAILS

- Each night after our hunts we will gather in the main lodge to enjoy dinner and conduct our “Manhood Discussions” where we talk about what it means to be a Christian man and what it means to be the spiritual leader of your family.
- Every man on the retreat must be present for the manhood discussions.



DETAILS

All hunts will be from elevated tower stands. All stands are corned at least once a week.

You will be taken to your stand before daybreak by a guide. You must remain in your stand until you are picked up. **NEVER** leave your stand for any reason.

If found away from your stand, your day's hunt and the remainder of your booked hunt will be terminated. No refunds will be issued for a terminated hunt.



THE HUNT

All firearms must remain unloaded with the actions open until you are safely in your stand. Unload your firearm when you hear your guide coming to pick you up.

Each hunter will be allowed to harvest one buck (12" or larger) and either one doe or one hog for a maximum of 2 animals.

Prior to allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to sign a liability waiver and show a Valid SC Hunting License.



LICENSE

All hunters are required to have a valid South Carolina Hunting License and Big Game Permit. Anyone born after 1979 must have a valid Hunters Safety Course ID to hunt in the state of South Carolina. **Non-residents must also purchase a \$50 buck tag.**

You can also obtain a license 24 hours a day, week by phone 1-866-714-3611. Most major are accepted.





Meals and snacks will be provided... including snacks that you can take with you to the treestand.



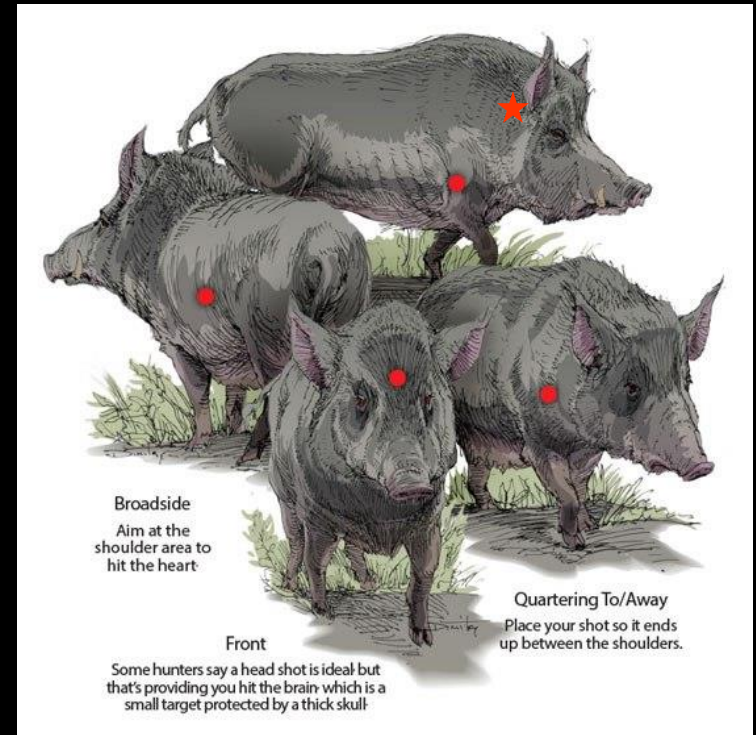
Please DO NOT leave trash on (or in) the stands.



TAKING YOUR SHOT

Hogs often grow a “plate” over the front quarter of their body that makes effective heart and lung shots difficult.

- Head shots to the ear with a large caliber rifle are the preferred method of harvest.
- Shotguns are not recommended
- If shooting a bow or crossbow, shot placement is key. A low-shot that is quartering away is crucial. If you hit a hog in the chest (“double-lung-shot”) the “plate” makes tracking and recovering the animal extremely difficult.





MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS

- During our three days together, we will gather as a group to conduct our “Manhood Discussions”
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, fatherhood and women to leadership, sports and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They’re Not Devotions and They’re Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully asked to be present for these discussions.



PACKING LISTS

MANDATORY

- Valid SC Hunting License
- Bow or Gun & Gun Case
ALL Guns **MUST** be transported
and stored in cases
- Hunter Orange Vest or Hat
- Flashlight
- Treestand safety harness
- Sleeping bag, Pillow and blanket
- No Personal Treestands Allowed
- No Alcohol allowed

SUGGESTED

- Rain Gear & Rubber Boots
- Cooler
- Bug Spray and/or Thermancell
- Rangefinder & Binoculars
- Cooler to take home "harvest"
- "Camp Chair"
- Cushion to sit on – while Hunting

REFUNDS

- Refunds can be given if more than 30 days before the retreat (minus the 3% credit card fee).
- A minimum nonrefundable deposit (usually 50% of hunt cost) is required upon booking a retreat. No retreat will be considered booked until Ironman Outdoors receives a deposit.



Our Policy:

BALANCE DUE

- Any outstanding or remaining reservation balance is due at least 14 days prior to the retreat.
- Any balances not paid within 14 days of a retreat will incur a \$50 late fee.
- All retreats must be paid in full before any hunting takes place.
