For this retreat, Ironman Outdoors has the exclusive hunting rights to over 1600 acres. This land includes over 20 food plots providing great habitat to deer and hogs.



Ironman Outdoors

- Your retreat will be guided by a ProStaff member of Ironman Outdoors.
- This means each guest will be taken to their stands prior to each hunt and each guest will be picked up at their stand at the end of each hunt.
- Stands will most likely be shooting houses on food plots and known travel areas.
- Each stand will be baited with corn (legal now in AL).

NEVER leave your stand at any time during a hunt.
There will be no stalking and no tracking of any animals without a guide present.





- For lodging, we have a farm house located on the hunting property.
- Each man will have his own bed.
- Linens are not provided.
- Please bring twin-sized sheets and/or sleeping bag.

Meals and snacks will be provided... including snacks that you can take with you to the treestand.



Please DO NOT leave trash on (or in) the stands.



HUNTING LICENSE

- Prior to allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to:
 - Sign a liability waiver
 - Show a Valid Hunting License for the state of AL.
- An Alabama hunting license is available for purchase on-line (non-resident 3 Day = \$142.00 and is valid for 72 hours from purchase).
- You will also need a Baiting Permit (\$51.85)
- **Note** - If you violate a game law, we will call the game warden and you will be asked to leave the retreat without refund.



HARVEST DETAILS

- During the retreat, each hunter will be allowed to harvest 1 buck (see antler restrictions) and 1 doe.
- During the retreat, each hunter will be allowed to harvest unlimited hogs.





All Bucks Harvested Must Have at least 4 points on one side and inside spread of at least 15 inches.

- The penalty for shooting a buck with less than the required minimum is \$150 donation to Ironman Outdoors for bucks greater than 14 inches wide. \$300 donation for bucks less than 14 inches wide.
- **Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.**
- Note: once you draw blood on a buck you are done hunting for bucks on that retreat (even if we don't find it).



Button Bucks

If you shoot a button buck on this retreat, that will count as your buck for the retreat. You will be doe hunting from then on.

- If you accidentally shoot a second button buck (while hunting for a doe), the fine is \$300.
- Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.





- We will have a location where you can skin and clean your harvest but we suggest that you bring a cooler to transport any meat harvested.
- If you have never cleaned a deer, our volunteers will be happy to assist you as you clean your deer.





MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS

- During our four days together, we will gather as a group to conduct our “Manhood Discussions”
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, fatherhood and women to leadership, sports and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They’re Not Devotions and They’re Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully expected to be present for these discussions.

Safety: if hunting from a treestand during the retreat, you must bring your own safety harness and wear it. Safety lifelines will be attached to every stand.





PACKING LISTS

MANDATORY

- Valid AL Hunting License
- Rifle and Hunter Orange Vest
- Flashlight and Treestand Safety Harness
- Towel & Scent-Free Soap
- Sleeping bag, Pillow and Blanket
- Hunting gear needed to keep you comfortable in the stand.
- No Personal Treestands Allowed
- No Alcohol allowed

SUGGESTED

- Rain Gear & Rubber Boots
- Cooler
- Bug Spray and/or Thermancell
- Rangefinder & Binoculars
- Cooler to take home "harvest"
- "Camp Chair"
- Cushion to sit on – while Hunting
- If you have only 1 favorite kind of soft drink....bring it with you.

Our Policy:

REFUNDS

- We can allow refunds if given 30 days notice before the retreat. We will subtract 3% if fees were paid with a card.
- No refunds within 30 days of the retreat.
- A deposit (usually 50% of hunt cost) is required upon booking a retreat. No retreat will be considered booked until Ironman Outdoors receives a deposit.



Our Policy:

BALANCE DUE

- Any outstanding or remaining reservation balance is due at least 14 days prior to the retreat.
- All retreats must be paid in full before any hunting takes place.
