Welcome to Ironman Outdoors

- We have the privilege of hunting on 1400 acres of private land in southern Alabama.

Cost: \$950 per man

Includes:

- Hunting from baited stands
- 6 hunts on private land
- Harvest of one buck and one doe
- Unlimited Hogs
- 4 days/3 nights lodging
- Meals and Snacks included
- Insurance
- Open to Men ages 18 and older
- No Trophy or Outfitter Fees

**Cost DOES NOT include AL Hunting License and Bait Permit
Alabama 3-day Hunting License and Bait Permit (non-resident) is \$231.40**

DETAILS

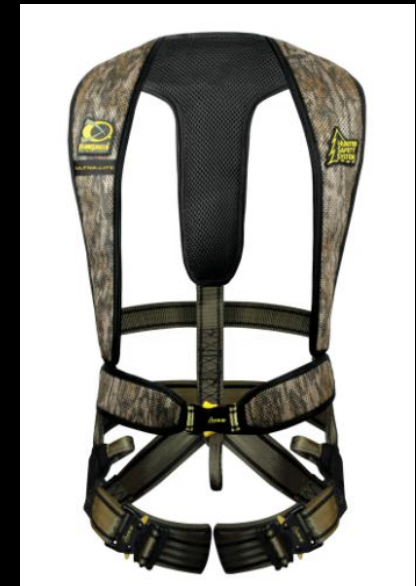
- We will be lodging at a cabin on the property. The cabin offers twin-sized bunk beds. NOTE: Linens are not provided.
- Each day we will gather in the great room to enjoy meals and conduct our “Manhood Discussions.”





DETAILS

- You will need to bring your own rifle with case.
- Safety: During the retreat, safety harnesses are mandatory while hunting from tree stands. You must bring and wear a safety harness. Safety lifelines will be attached to every stand.

DETAILS

- We will have a place to skin and clean animals that we harvest but we suggest that you bring a large cooler to transport them home.
- Prior to allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to sign a liability waiver and show a Valid Alabama Hunting License and baiting permit.
- If you violate a game law, you will be asked to leave the retreat without refund.

DETAILS

- Our hunts will be guided by the volunteers of Ironman Outdoors.
- This means each guest will be taken to their stands prior to each hunt, and each guest will be picked up at their stand at the end of each hunt.
- Box Stands/ladder stands will have feeders or corn nearby.
- NEVER leave your stand at any time during a hunt.
- This means there will be no stalking and no tracking of any animals without a guide present.
- Please DO NOT leave trash on (or in) the stands.
- No cleaning fees or tips required.

DETAILS

- All Bucks Harvested Must Have at least 4 points on one side and a minimum inside spread of at least 15 inches.
- During the retreat, each hunter is allowed to harvest 1 doe and 1 buck (that meets the size requirements) and unlimited hogs.
- The penalty for shooting a buck with less than the required minimum size is \$500.
- Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.
- NOTE: once you draw blood on a buck you are done hunting for bucks on that retreat (even if we don't find it).

DETAILS

Button Bucks

- If you shoot a button buck on this retreat, either (1) that will count as your buck for the retreat or (2) you must pay the \$500 fine.
- Before going back to the woods, the hunter must decide and let IO know if they are going with option 1 or option 2.
- Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.

Packing Lists

MANDATORY

- Valid AL Hunting License and Baiting Permit
- Rifle with case
 - ALL Guns MUST** be transported unloaded and stored in cases
- Hunter Orange Hat and/or Vest
- Tree Stand Safety Harness
- Flashlight with batteries
- Towel and Scent-Free soap
- Sleeping Bag and Pillow
- No alcohol allowed

SUGGESTED

- Comfortable boots are strongly suggested
- Rain/snow/cold weather gear
- Camera
- Binoculars
- Rangefinder
- Extra batteries for your flashlight
- Cooler to transport harvest
- Cushion to sit on
- Thermacell device



MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS

- During our time together, we will gather as a group to conduct our “Manhood Discussions”
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, women, and fatherhood to leadership, sports, and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They’re Not Devotions and They’re Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully expected to be present for these discussions.



Our Policy:

REFUNDS

- We can allow refunds if given 30 days notice before the retreat. We will subtract 3% if fees were paid with a card.
- No refunds within 30 days of the retreat.
- A deposit (usually 50% of hunt cost) is required upon booking a retreat. No retreat will be considered booked until Ironman Outdoors receives a deposit.

BALANCE DUE

- Any outstanding or remaining reservation balance is due at least 14 days prior to the retreat.
- All retreats must be paid in full before any hunting takes place.
