# **Fishing License**

- Prior to allowing anyone to fish, each attendee will be required to:
  - Sign a liability waiver
  - Show a Valid Fishing License for the state of Pennsylvania.

Fishing License ONLY Required for individuals that are <u>16 years & older</u>

 Note - If you violate a game law, you will be asked to leave the retreat without refund.



# Fishing License Options (16 years and older)

- Resident Fishing License
  - Annual \$25.47
  - 1-Day Resident \$13.22
  - Lake Erie Permit \$9.97 (Required)
- Nonresident Fishing License
  - Annual \$56.97
  - 1-Day Tourist \$29.47 (Includes Lake Erie Permit)
  - 3-Day Tourist \$29.47
  - Lake Erie Permit \$9.97 (Required)



# HARVEST LIMITS

- All legal fish can be kept by the fisherman.
- We will have a place to clean the fish and suggest you bring a cooler to transport any fish harvested.
- No cleaning fees or tips are expected but help with cleaning fish is welcomed.
