- Species taken include: trout, redfish and the occasional cobia.




- Ironman Outdoors will supply the boats, each provided by a fisherman who has extensive experience pursuing these fish.

- Our fishing trips will be guided by experienced fisherman and pro-staffers of Ironman Outdoors.
- If you have a good rod with 20lb test line on it, you are welcome to bring it. Otherwise, rod and reels can be provided by the pro staffers with advance notice.
- Primarily artificial lures are used on this trip.
- Lightweight spinning reels are recommended.

Lodging

- Lodging will be at a waterfront house.
- Each man will have his own bed.





- License Details
 - A Florida Saltwater fishing license is required. Price is \$17 for resident and \$17 for non-resident 3 day permit. Website address is www.myfwc.com.



- We suggest that you bring a cooler to transport any fish that you catch home with you.
- Prior to leaving the dock, each attendee will be required to sign a liability waiver and show a valid fishing license for the state of Florida.







- Meals and snacks will be provided....including snacks/ lunch that you can take with you in the boat.
- Any fish caught that can legally be kept maybe kept by the fisherman. There will be places available to clean fish and the pro-staffers will have fillet knives and can assist in cleaning fish if require
