- Our fishing trips are guided by experienced fisherman and pro-staffers of Ironman Outdoors.
- If you have a good rod with 20lb test line on it, you are welcome to bring it. With advanced notice rods and reels can be provided by the pro staffers.
- Primarily artificial lures are used on this trip.
- Lightweight spinning reels are recommended. Something you would use to Bass Fish with.
