Welcome to Ironman Outdoors

For this retreat, we have the privilege of hunting a private ranch near Cherokee Tx, which is in the middle of the beautiful Texas Hill Country.

This ranch is a long the Cherokee Creek, one of the only creeks that consistently holds water in the area. Traditionally the ranch has held a lot of birds.





- Your hunts will be facilitated by a volunteer of Ironman Outdoors.
- The Pro-Staffer will assign each hunter a portion of the ranch assigned by a draw. We will use OnX to draw these lines on a map. Each hunter must stay in his zone.
- Each hunter should be prepared with his own calls and decoys.

HUNTING LICENSE

- Prior to allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to:
 - Sign a liability waiver
 - Show a Valid Hunting License for the state of TX.
 - Non-residence Spring Turkey license is \$126 per man and you will also need the Upland Game Bird Endorsement for an additional \$7.
 - All hunters must have completed a Hunter Safety Certification course (in any state) and have proof of completion.
- **Note** - If you violate a game law, you will be asked to leave the retreat without refund.



HARVEST LIMITS

- During the retreat, each hunter will be allowed to harvest 1 Rio Grande Gobbler.
- This ranch has lots of hogs, so if the opportunity presents itself you can shoot as many hogs as you would like.
- Coyotes may be shot at no additional cost as well.
- We will have a place for each hunter to skin and clean your harvest but we suggest that you bring a cooler to transport any meat harvested.





Manhood Discussions

- During our retreat , we will gather as a group to conduct our “Manhood Discussions”
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, fatherhood and leadership, sports and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They’re Not Devotions and They’re Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully asked to be present for these discussions.



PACKING LISTS

MANDATORY

- Valid TX Hunting License
- Shotgun with turkey loads
- Hunting Knife
- Quality pair of binoculars!
- Flashlight
- Calls and decoys
- Sleeping bag, Pillow and blanket
- No Alcohol allowed
- Ice Chest to take home harvest

SUGGESTED

- Leather boots
- Cooler
- "Camp Chair"
- Cushion to sit on – while Hunting
- Highly recommend sighting in rifle prior to coming, will save time on the range.
- Rifle in the event you decide to hunt hogs and predators.

Our Policy:

REFUNDS

- We can provide a refund (minus 3% credit card fees) if you give us more than 30 days notice before the retreat. Less than 30 days before the retreat, there are no refunds.
- A minimum nonrefundable deposit (usually 50% of hunt cost) is required upon booking a retreat. No retreat will be considered booked until Ironman Outdoors receives a deposit.



Our Policy:

BALANCE DUE

Any outstanding or remaining reservation balance is due at least 14 days prior to the retreat.

All retreats must be paid in full before any hunting takes place.
