WELCOME

Welcome to Ironman Outdoors

- We have the privilege of hunting a low-fence Texas Hill Country Ranch on over 900 acres.

DETAILS

- There is a nice 10-bedroom lodge on the ranch that offers both twin and queen-sized beds.
- Each evening, we will gather in the lodge where we'll enjoy meals and conduct our *Manhood Discussions*.





DETAILS

Guests will need to bring their own rifle and case.

Hunts will be conducted out of shooting houses or ladder stands with feeders or corn nearby.

Safety: During the retreat, safety harnesses are mandatory while hunting from tree stands. You must bring and wear a safety harness. Safety lifelines will be attached to every stand.

DETAILS

We will have a place to skin and clean animals that we harvest, but we suggest that you bring a large cooler to transport them home. Guest are responsible for cleaning their own animals, but IO volunteers will assist if needed.

Before allowing anyone to hunt, each attendee will be required to sign a liability waiver and show a Valid Texas Hunting License.

If you violate a game law, you will be asked to leave the retreat without a refund.

DETAILS

- Our hunts are guided by the volunteers of Ironman Outdoors.
- This means each guest will be taken to their stand before each hunt, and each guest will be picked up at their stand at the end of each hunt.
- NEVER leave your stand at any time during a hunt. This means there will be no stalking and no tracking of any animals without a guide present.
- Please DO NOT leave trash on (or in) the stands.
- No cleaning fees or tips required.

DETAILS

- All Buck harvests must have at least 4 points on one side and a minimum inside spread of 16 inches.
- During the retreat, each guest can harvest 1 buck (that meets the minimum size requirements) and 1 doe.
- There is a **\$750 Penalty** for shooting a buck under the required minimum size. Fines must be paid before leaving the retreat.
- NOTE: Once a guest draws blood on a buck, the guest can then only hunt for a doe and potentially hogs for the remainder of the retreat (even if we don't find your buck).

DETAILS



Button Bucks

- If a guest shoots a button buck on this retreat, they have two options:
 1. The button buck will count as their harvested buck for the retreat.
 2. The guest must pay a \$750 fine to continue hunting for a legal buck.
- Before going back to the woods, the guest must decide and let IO know if they are going with option 1 or option 2.
- All fines must be paid before leaving the retreat.

- Rifle in a case
 - ALL Guns MUST be transported unloaded and stored in cases
- Rangefinder
- Safety Harness
- Flashlight with batteries
- Towel and Scent-Free soap
- Sleeping Bag and Pillow
- NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED

SUGGESTED

- Comfortable boots are strongly suggested
- Rain/snow/cold weather gear
- Camera
- Binoculars
- Extra batteries for your flashlight
- Cooler to transport harvest
- Cushion to sit on
- Thermacell device
- Portable Heater (Heater Buddy)
