

Father/Son Deer and Hog Retreat

White Oak, SC Nov. 13-16, 2025





Welcome to Ironman Outdoors

We have the privilege of hunting several hundred acres of private land near White Oak, SC. Fairfield County, SC has long been a producer of big bucks!







- We stay at a Christian camp adjacent to the property. The camp offer hotel style rooms with 2 beds and a bathroom. Linens are provided.
- Each evening we will gather at the camp where we'll enjoy meals and conduct our "Manhood Discussions."







Father and Son Retreat at White Oak, SC

Cost: \$800 per family (1 father, 1 son)

- Cost includes:
- 3 full days of hunting
- 3 nights lodging included
- All meals and Snacks included
- Boys should be between 8-15 years old

Cost DOES NOT include SC Hunting Licenses



- You will need to bring your own rifle in a case.
- We will mostly be hunting out of shooting blinds over corn, some stands have food plots.
- NOTE: Fathers and Sons will be sitting together at all times.







- All Bucks Harvest must have at least 4 points on one side and a minimum inside spread of at least 15 inches. During the retreat, each hunter can harvest 1 buck (that meets the size requirements) and 1 doe.
- Penalty for shooting a buck with less than the required minimum size is \$500. Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.
- NOTE: once you draw blood on a buck, you will only be hunting doe the rest of the retreat (even if we don't find your buck).
- LIMIT: 1 buck and 1 doe per family for the retreat.





Button Bucks

- If you shoot a button buck on this retreat, either (1) that will count as your buck for the retreat or (2) you must pay the \$500 fine.
- Before going back to the woods, the hunter must decide and let IO know if they are going with option 1 or option 2.
- Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.



MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS

- During our time together, we will gather as a group to conduct our "Manhood Discussions"
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, and fatherhood, to leadership, sports, and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They're Not Devotions and They're Not Sermons.
- Every father and son on the retreat is respectfully expected to be present for these discussions.

- -Valid SC Hunting License
- -Rifle in case

ALL Guns **MUST** be transported unloaded and stored in cases

- -Orange hat or vest
- -Towel / Scent-free Soap
- -Flashlight with Batteries
- -Cooler to transport meat home
- -Sleeping Bag and Pillow
- -No alcohol allowed

SUGGESTED

- -Comfortable boots are strongly suggested
- -Rain/snow/cold weather Gear
- -Camera
- -Binoculars
- -Cushion to sit on

Sunday, Nov. 16


- 6:00am Hunt

Our Policy:

REFUNDS

- •We can allow refunds if given 30 days notice before the retreat. We will subtract 3% if fees were paid with a card.
- No refunds within 30 days of the retreat.
- •A deposit (usually 50% of hunt cost) is required upon booking a retreat. No retreat will be considered booked until Ironman Outdoors receives a deposit.



Our Policy:

BALANCE DUE

- •Any outstanding or remaining reservation balance is due at least 14 days prior to the retreat.
- •All retreats must be paid in full before any hunting takes place.
