Welcome to Ironman Outdoors

- We have the privilege of hunting a private farm near Richmond, OH! The farm is adjacent to a State Park with very little hunting pressure. This retreat will be limited to 5 guests.





DETAILS

- We will be lodging at a house in a nearby campground. The house offers twin sized beds and a couple of queen beds.
- Each evening we will gather at the house where we'll enjoy meals and conduct our "Manhood Discussions."
- The house is about a 10 min drive from the farm.
- **There is no cell phone service at the house.**

- There is no cell phone service at the house.
- However, there is cell service at the top of the hunting property and also while we are driving to and from the farm.





Hunt Deer in Ohio

Cost: \$1000 per man

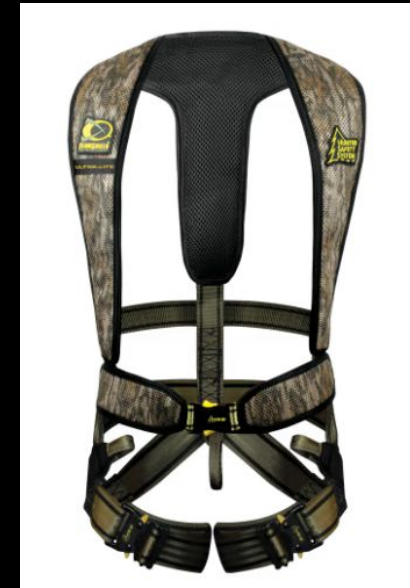
- Cost includes:
- 3 full days of hunting
- 3 nights lodging included
- All meals and Snacks included
- Open to Men ages 18 and older

Cost DOES NOT include OH Hunting Licenses



DETAILS

- You will need to bring your own bow or crossbow.
- You will also need to bring a treestand safety harness.
- Most of our stands will be Millenium ladderstands.





DETAILS – please read!

- This is a steep property that we can only access via ATV.
- You will need to be able to carry everything on your back or in your hands with you to hunt.
- There could be some hiking involved.
- **If you aren't comfortable riding on the back of an ATV up a steep slope, please don't book this retreat.**





DETAILS –

- This area is known for big bucks. And we will be hunting this retreat during the peak of the rut!





MANHOOD DISCUSSIONS

- During our time together, we will gather as a group to conduct our “Manhood Discussions”
- These discussions are simply an authentic and transparent conversation about what it means to be a Christian man.
- Topics may range from hunting, work, fatherhood, and women to leadership, sports, and everyday life.
- These are Not Bible Studies, They’re Not Devotions and They’re Not Sermons.
- Every man on the retreat is respectfully expected to be present for these discussions.



Packing Lists

MANDATORY

- Valid OH Hunting License and Permit
- Bow or crossbow
- Rangefinder
- Tree Stand Safety Harness
- Flashlight with batteries
- Towel and Scent-Free soap
- Sleeping Bag and Pillow
- No alcohol allowed

SUGGESTED

- Comfortable boots are strongly suggested
- Rain/snow/cold weather Gear
- Binoculars
- Extra batteries for your flashlight
- Cooler to transport harvest
- Cushion to sit on
- Thermacell

DETAILS

Our hunts will be guided by the volunteers of Ironman Outdoors.

This means each guest will be taken to their stands prior to each hunt, and each guest will be picked up at their stand at the end of each hunt.

Ladder stands will have corn nearby.

NEVER leave your stand at any time during a hunt.

This means there will be no stalking and no tracking of any animals without a guide present.

Please DO NOT leave trash on (or in) the stands.

No tips. It is your responsibility to clean your deer, but if you need help our volunteers will assist you.

DETAILS

All Bucks Harvested must meet this minimum criteria:

4 points on one side AND at least 16" wide inside spread

During the retreat, each hunter will be allowed to harvest 1 doe and 1 buck (that meets the size requirements).

The penalty for shooting a buck less than the required minimum size is \$500.

Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.

NOTE: once you draw blood on a buck you are done hunting for bucks on that retreat (even if we don't find it).

DETAILS

Button Bucks

If you shoot a button buck on this retreat, either (1) that will count as your buck for the retreat or (2) you must pay the \$500 fine.

Before going back to the woods, the hunter must decide and let IO know if they are going with option 1 or option 2.

Payment will be collected before you leave the retreat.



Our Policy:

REFUNDS PLEASE READ:

- We grant refunds up to 60 days before the retreat. We will subtract 3% to cover card fees incurred by the ministry when you booked.
- No refunds will be given within 60 days of the retreat. If you have to cancel, we will use your fee as a scholarship for another man who can't afford the full amount.

BALANCE DUE

- Any outstanding or remaining reservation balance is due at least 14 days prior to the retreat.
- All retreats must be paid in full before any hunting takes place.
