How?	A free site that acts as a volunteer Human Resource Department for communities as a whole. Volunteer-minded people <b>easily self-select personalized passion-aligned service involvement</b> utilizing Service Opportunity Descriptions (Job Descriptions) that clarify the work and time involved.		
What?	The unique Community Service And Support Network approach facilitates and refreshes city-wide collaborations. This very simple yet profound approach helps people quickly sort through the myriads of community service options. Each are supported by individuals we call Connectors who volunteer their time to vet and connect people on behalf and in support of one non-profit. Connectors are passion-aligned individuals who work to help their Executive Director reduce ancillary expenses while also adding mission critical volunteer roles.
