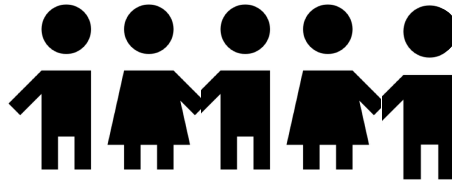

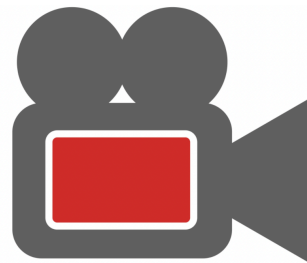
Children of an incarcerated parent are five times more likely to be incarcerated
