Moldova: Stars in the East

And those who have insight will shine like the glow of the expanse of heaven, and those who lead the many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever Daniel 12:3

Life in the Eastern European bloc has been very difficult for many years. Life as part of the USSR was difficult: financially, spiritually and intellectually. Spiritually the choices were atheism or orthodoxy. Neither choice connected people to the abundant life that Jesus brings. But there was a growing population who knew the Lord and interceded for others even though they were persecuted.

A healthy church should be a growing church. Evangelism is a firm foundation of the Circle of Love. We worked with several new church plants even one inside a nursing home. One church that we worked with in Ungeny, has planted 17 churches in the past 5 years. Several churches are reaching out to the community with bread distribution. They actually make the bread in the church using industrial ovens and mixers that can make 43 loaves at once and 7 batches a day. People can come for free bread and, of course, receive bread when they come to church.

Along with the bread, the Bread of Life is also served. We always share the Gospel in our medical outreaches. In this trip to Moldova, we worked in 7 churches. At one church, we served 70 Ukrainian refugees. We also treated people at a nursing home. We treated 401 patients with 61 salvations and 13 rededications. 1046 prescriptions were dispensed. 82 patients received steroid injections for chronic knee or shoulder pain. We dispensed 200 pairs of glasses.



Water is the elixir of life. Crossroads KZN has been working in the Osindisweni Valley in South Africa for many years now. Due to the high mountains and deep valleys, the water table is quite deep. Water security has been a big problem here as the area is beyond what is served by Durban city water. People have to rely on buying water tanks and getting them filled from water trucks. In some greas, water was scarce because people, usually women or children, had to carry it long distances. This led to water borne diseases and skin problems related to infrequent bathing. Until recently, it was considered impossible to drill wells there. However, a few months ago, 3 of the sites where Crossroads works were predicted to have water tables which could be reached by a borehole. (well). Drilling has been done at the first two sites, Mayika and Mtuketeli. Praise God people can now drink freely.





South African Home Builders

Since 2022, 19 ladies in Mayika wanted to build new houses. They have been busy making building blocks. When 1,000 blocks are done, they build one house. Crossroads KZN provided the foundation, windows, a door, and the roof. The last house is now up!! Congratulations, hard-working ladies! Thanks to all at Circle of Love and Forest City Fellowship who sponsored the materials.

Crossroads Peer Education

The peer program is an effective method of empowering the youth from disadvantaged backgrounds to not have disadvantaged futures, but rather confront the issues of risky behaviors, and uplift themselves and others through informed decision-making. We believe that individual change leads to group change which in turn leads to community change. Crossroads KZN provides leadership for this program. The 2025 class has just graduated. Congratulations to all the students who have finished this program. May the Lord bless you as you continue to be influencers for good.
