Jesus is Lord!

The authority I walk in is the authority of Jesus. It's not mine. It's not based on my works. It's not based on my name. It is based on the name of Jesus.

I walk in power. I walk in authority. I walk in ability; the very ability of God, Himself. I am filled with all the fullness of God, because I have the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost abiding in me; dwelling in me. They don't come and go. They dwell, and I dwell in them.

I love all men. I love God with all my heart, all my soul, and all my strength. I love all men as I love myself. I treat others the way I want to be treated; therefore, I walk in the way of life. I do not walk in the way of death.

My path is light. God directs my steps. As I make my plans, I expect the Holy Spirit to tell me of things to come, and that forms my plans. My plans are of God, because I acknowledge Him in all my ways.

I don't lean to my own understanding. I do not lean to my own strength, but I am strengthened with Christ. I am strengthened with His might,

His blood makes me free. His blood makes me righteous. His sacrifice made me acceptable, and I am accepted in the beloved. I am accepted by God. I am accepted by Jesus Christ.

His Spirit lives in me, walks in me, and talks in me. He is my God, and I am His child. I am a son, manifesting the name and the glory of God to this world. I am maturing. I am not carnal; I am spiritual.

I do not take offense; I refuse to take offense. I refuse to give unnecessary offense, but I will not compromise the Gospel or the truth of the Word of God.

I am teachable. I am correctable. I will listen. I will seek good counsel. I will listen to spiritual people who have words of the Spirit to speak into my life.

I look forward to growth and to any discomfort that growth may cause, because I know resistance provides strength.

By the Spirit of God, I am healed, I am delivered, and I am free. My mind is guarded. I take heed to what I hear and to whom I listen. I take heed to separate myself from the wicked. I do not sit in the seat of the scornful.

I walk in the company of the wise. I walk in the fullness of the Spirit, and the Spirit speaks through me. My words will be the words of

God. My words are spirit, and they are life. They bring life; they provide life.

My words are seasoned with grace, and they bring edification to every person under the sound of my voice. I will speak that which is true, and I will speak the truth in love.

I purpose myself to become love personified. I purpose myself to give ground, to give up my rights and not to enforce my rights, and to lay down my life for others, so in the name of Jesus, I am forgiven. I have confessed any sin, and I am cleansed by the blood of Jesus. I am made whole.

I am now righteous by the blood of Jesus. His mind, His thoughts, His objectives, and His plans are mine. I have laid down my life and taken up His. I take up my cross; every day. Every day, I take up my cross!

All power has been given unto Jesus, and therefore, since my life is hid in Christ, the authority and power of Jesus Christ is the power and authority that I walk in. It is not my authority. It is His authority, for it is no longer I that live, but Christ who lives through me.

The life that I now live, I live by the faith of the Son of God, who lived and died and gave Himself for me.

This is how I know that I am born of God: I love the unlovable. I bless my enemies. I bless those that curse me. I bless those that spitefully use me.

I give myself to man, to be used and even abused, to know the fullness of the sacrifice of Christ so that I may know Him, and make Him known. “That I may know Him and the power of His resurrection...” I give myself so that His power may be fully manifested through my life, spirit, soul, and body.

I am complete, in Christ, who lives in me. He is the Head. I am His body. He gives me the thoughts; I speak His words. I go where He wants me to go. I am His feet, I am His hands, I am His mouth, and I am His eyes. He walks in me, talks in me, talks through me, and helps me to talk to others. He provides all power, and I provide the action.

I let the mind of Christ dwell in me. I have that mind, because I am born again. I am a new creature, in Christ. Old things are passed away; all things have become new. All things are of God.
