The "O Antiphon" of Advent: Wisdom Isaiah 11:2-4

Since the ninth century, the Church has used the "O Antiphons" in their Advent worship. The "O Antiphons" are Advent prayers that address Christ Jesus by one of His Old Testament prophetic titles. The hymn, "Oh Come, Oh Come Emmanuel" is based upon these "antiphon" titles. This Advent we join with our Old Testament brothers and sister in Christ in recalling God's promises and celebrating their fulfillment at Christmas.

O ROOT OF JESSE

P: Come, Gracious Lord, our hearts renew

C: Come, that we may celebrate Christmas in joyous faith

P: Come, O Root of Jesse, standing as a banner before the peoples, before whom all nations will bow.

C: Come quickly to deliver us.

P: Hear the Word of the Lord ...

(Isaiah 11:1,10) A Shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. ... In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious

P: This is the Word of the Lord.

C: Thanks be to God!

P: Come, Lord Jesus!

C: Come quickly, Emmanuel!

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON Isaiah 40: 1-5

Comfort, comfort my people, says your God. 2 Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and proclaim to her that her hard service has been completed, that her sin has been paid for, that she has received from the LORD's hand double for all her sins. 3 A voice of one calling: "In the wilderness prepare the way for the LORD; make straight in the desert a highway for our God. 4 Every valley shall be raised up, every mountain and hill made low; the rough ground shall become level, the rugged places a plain. 5 And the glory of the LORD will be revealed, and all people will see it together. For the mouth of the LORD has spoken."

NEW TESTAMENT LESSON 1 Timothy 2: 1-6

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people— 2 for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. 3 This is good, and pleases God our Savior, 4 who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. 5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, 6 who gave himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed to at the proper time.

HOLY GOSPEL Luke 3: 1-6

P: The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the 3rd chapter.
