Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may have dominion over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground." 27 So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. 28 God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Exercise dominion over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground."

NEW TESTAMENT LESSON Romans 12: 1-9

I urge you, in view of God's mercy, to offer yourselves as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God, this is your true and proper worship. 2 Stop not conforming to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is, his good, pleasing and perfect will. 3 For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you. 4 Just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, 5 so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. 6 We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; 7 if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; 8 if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully. 9 Love is to be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good.

HOLY GOSPEL Mark 12:38-44

These men will receive greater condemnation." 41 Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury.
