





Since we have flesh and blood, [Jesus] shared our humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil—and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death. For it is not angels he helps, but Abraham's descendants. For this reason he needed to be made like us, fully human in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people. – Hebrews 2:14-17

Blessed October! As we do every October this month we pause to celebrate the Reformation. That time 500 years ago when God used Martin Luther to restore the Church's focus to good news of God in Christ Jesus. In our celebration we focus on Grace, Scripture and Faith. For we are redeemed and reconciled (Cf. Galatians 3:13; Colossians 1:21-22; Romans 6:23; Titus 3:4-7) to our holy God only through his Grace (Cf. Romans 5:6-8 & Ephesians 2:8-9). And, we know this good news only through His Revelation in Scripture (Cf. 2 Timothy 3:14-16 & Romans 1:16-17). And we are able to comprehend, trust, and believe in this goodness of God only through Faith. (Cf. Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Corinthians 12:3; Psalm 13:5-6; Isaiah 25:9). In humble awe we contemplate the question of the Psalmist: 'When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them?' (Psalm 8:3-4) And we rejoice proclaiming: 'Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression? ... You do not stay angry forever rather you delight in showing mercy.' (Micah 7:18) This is what our celebration of the Reformation is all about.

Truly God is good but, while Luther's theology gets to the heart of the Gospel, nothing elicits that deep seated sense of awe like God's own Word. In the passage above, Hebrews 2:14-17, God dives deep into the details of our Redemption. Jesus, the very Son of God, (Cf. John 1:1-5; John 3:16-17) takes on our nature, our flesh (v14), walking obediently with God and then, being our faithful high priest, (v17) takes the burden of our failures and sins on his own shoulders. (Cf. Isaiah 53:4-6; 2 Corinthians 5:19,21; Romans 5:6-8) This is our Redemption! This is the good news of God! This IS our God! God 'helps' sinners. (v16) God, in Christ Jesus, overcomes both the consequence of our sin (death) as well as the influence, power, and control of the one who uses the reality of that consequence to enslave us to fear and hopelessness. (v15).

So, join us this October as we, in trusting Faith, rejoice in the Grace of God, as revealed in Scripture.




Secret Prayer Sisters An undercover friend praying to God on your behalf.

Small groups within a congregation provide support, encouragement, education and perceptions on lifeperceptions in terms of the context of faith; perceptions that "put our reality into the perspective of God" (Pastor Busch, May 15, 2022).

Circles of Friends are groups of seven to eleven folks who meet together (they decide how often; suggested at least once a month) at the times that work best for the people in their group. They share food (dinner, breakfast, dessert, whatever the group decides), and share their lives and faith (they may just talk about life, have a Bible study, have a devotion, or however they as a group decide to talk about their faith in life). They may meet in their homes, at restaurants; it's up to their group and what works best for them. The result is a special group of friends growing in their faith life, and that growing faith life is reflected in their homes and church family as well.


