On June 12<sup>th</sup>, we took Tressa's mom to visit her brother, Norman. You all know him as Tressa's "Uncle Norman". It was a wonderful visit. Norman (fondly known to most as "Norm") had been recovering extremely well after his great battle with Leukemia in 2023. Yes, he was weaker but he was walking with a cane and even driving!

Unfortunately, the very next day after our visit, Norman became extremely ill. For weeks, he had no strength to get out of bed and no appetite. We arranged for Caregivers to come to the house as he lives 40 miles away from us. After two hospital stays, we received the diagnosis. Something had attacked his heart — whether it be viral or the oral chemotherapy he was taking, Norman was in Stage IV Heart Failure and now required skilled 24-hour care.

On July 30<sup>th</sup>, Norman entered Hospice care and entered Maplewood Nursing Home – thankfully, just 10 minutes from our home which enabled us to visit him every day and care for his physical, emotional and spiritual needs.

As happened everywhere with "Norm", the staff fell in love with him. Even in the midst of his suffering, he called them "family". Our daily visits to Norman became precious times as he would relay stories of his life as an award winning journalist and novelist. He was a man of many interests and took great interest in people. He was gifted to relay stories through the written word.

Norman and Ray became quite close. Norman would ask Ray to give him lessons from the Bible. He requested daily Scriptures (as he was too weak to read the Bible for himself). On

August 15<sup>th</sup>, Norman called upon the Lord to save him – entrusting his future hope in the death, burial and resurrection of God's only way of salvation – the Lord Jesus Christ...and Norman kept wanting to hear more from the Bible.

Norman never regained his appetite and lost over 30 pounds in 3 months. Unfortunately, our area experienced a vast Covid outbreak, and Norman became ill. On Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, God called Norman home to heaven. **Our Lord Jesus Christ truly is the Great Hope of Heaven.** God promises in His Word that those who have placed their faith in Christ – like Norman did – will live in Christ's wondrous presence in heaven to love, worship and adore Him forever. In heaven, we will sin against God no more and live in a place that has no sin, sickness, sorrow, or death.

**Dear Ones, Life is hastening quickly away! Eternity is at the door! Are you living for eternity?** Are you living to love and serve Christ with a whole heart? Do you seek God's glory in all things? Are you sharing God's Good News of Salvation in Christ with souls in need of Great Hope? Norman was in good health on June 12<sup>th</sup>. On June 13<sup>th</sup> everything changed! And, by God's grace, on September 29<sup>th</sup>, he became absent from his body and present with the Lord!


Yes, this summer has been very wearying, but the nearness of God has been our strength. God truly is our Refuge and Strength, a very present Help in trouble.
