As 2023 comes to a close, we have countless reasons to bless the Lord for the storm as well as the calm. 2023 has been a year full of storms!



The year began with Tressa's Uncle literally near death as he underwent cancer treatments for leukemia. As his power of attorney, there was much care and concern to make correct decisions! By God's grace, He took hold of my right hand and with His counsel He guided (Psalm 73:24). God directed and poured out His mercy on Uncle Norman! He left the rehab facility in March;

returned home; his strength is increasing steadily; and his bloodwork is fantastic! One of the most precious outcomes of this storm is a rich relationship with our uncle - truly a gift brought about by the Lord.

In February, Tressa's 89-year-old mom was hospitalized for a lodged kidney stone – her first. She was weak; there was infection; recovery took several weeks. As mom progressed in healing and regaining her strength, the nearness of God was our strength and our song and we are filled with praises unto Him. Storms tend to build our faith and reliance upon Him!



In May, our beloved pastor of 17 years answered God's call to another church. This left us with no senior pastor. As the elders searched for a new pastor, strife-disputes-gossipand outbursts of anger erupted from various members of the congregation. It was a time of great turmoil and pain that eventually led to most of the faithful leaving the church in September now finding ourselves as sheep without a shepherd. But Jesus – the Good and Great Shepherd of His sheep – watches over the souls of His beloved sheep and is

leading us all in His paths of righteousness as we seek a new shepherd and congregation. This has been a huge storm! But the nearness of God our Savior-the Lord Jesus Christ-is good and our cup overflows as we walk by faith with Him and He leads us in paths of righteousness for His Name's sake (Psalm 23).



In July, Ray herniated two discs in his lower back. Coupled with arthritis and stenosis, he was rapidly losing strength in his left leg. Shots were ineffective. On September 14th, he underwent surgery in the L4-L5 lumbar area. This was Ray's first surgery since his immunotherapy cancer treatments in 2019. While we praise God that the cancer treatments rendered Ray cancer free for now four years, the treatments greatly altered his immune system. Thus, recovery from September's back surgery has been extremely difficult.

Ray's recovery after surgery fluctuated; pain was steady; sometimes excruciating pain would flare up rendering him hunched over a walker. Long story short, an MRI done ten weeks after surgery revealed infection in the spine (bone). On November 30th, Ray went in for another surgery to clean out the area and take cultures for data in treatment. By God's grace, we are now on a course of treatment. Currently he is on two oral antibiotics as well as a weekly infusion at the hospital – and his body is responding to treatment! The best part is that he is no longer experiencing excruciating pain. Of course, Ray's physical body is weak because of the inability to use his muscles for six months.


Charles Spurgeon once said,
