Expect the supernatural.

Stir up a desire for the tangible expression of heaven on earth. Reach out and pull back the veil that separates us from the consuming fire of God.

Many times when we pray nothing happens because we expect nothing.

Recognize the supernatural.

The supernatural always lines up with the word. If you know the word you will recognize the supernatural.

Look for the supernatural.

What would the supernatural look like? Something is affected; it's the ability of the power of the kingdom of heaven to alter things around you big or small. Stop looking for the **spectacular** or you will miss the supernatural.

Define supernatural.

Anything you can't do and the ability of God intervenes. The supernatural is the normal existence of God as we observe it from our low perspective. There is only our natural and God's natural. This earth dwells within the borders of the kingdom of heaven. Think about the natural of God in your life everyday.

Expect God's natural to become our natural!

John 14:8-15

8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?

10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

The supernatural is not to prove the existence of God.

Jesus was saying that Philip was seeing the Father in every deed that he preformed because it was the Father in him doing the works.

The supernatural comes from the Father, God.

God lives in us. The supernatural comes from God in us it is the mark of God's presence.

The supernatural happens to express the nature, character and heart of God.

The supernatural displays my "Daddy", Abba Father. It is His way of doing things. God always has a point to what He does. If there is no point it is probably not God. What God does is designed to facilitate the preaching of the gospel, it brings heaven to earth.

The supernatural operates through the cooperation of believers.

God rarely does anything without believers.

Jesus does the works so it is faith in Him that is the catalyst for the supernatural.

You lay hands on the sick and they recover. It is God in Jesus doing the works.

John 14:12-13 2 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

It doesn't say he that believes he can do the works of Jesus shall do the works I do. It is not you have faith for a miracle for someone. **You aren't the power plant.** It's not you praying harder and getting anointed, it's not your faith and anointing. It's he that believeth on Jesus. Your confidence should not be you can do the works of Jesus but he that believeth on Jesus. The Faith is directed to Him! The more you know concerning Jesus the more confidence you have to step out. It's Jesus in you doing the works. When I pray, my confidence is in Jesus can do something for you. If I introduce you to Jesus, he can alter your life and world. You qualify to do the supernatural.

Your job it to know what God wants to do for people.

Jesus is looking at the sinner and thinking, "if I could just get my hands on him I could alter his life!" Jesus mostly healed spiritually dead men not new creatures. Sin never stopped Jesus from touching people's lives. Your faith should always be directed toward

God. Believers aren't sure God wants to do anything for anybody, that's the reason nothing happens. Forget about trying to straighten people out, He's a lot better at it than we are.

The more you know He is a good Jesus and He wants to help people the more your confidence and boldness will increase and the more He will be able to do through you.

Right living is not the prerequisite for healing. Ask yourself," What does Jesus want to do for these people?" Don't ask what can I do for you? It is not Faith to work a miracle but Faith in the Miracle Worker! What do you know about Jesus? We have made it our faith and anointing and the church has dwindled in power.

The fullness of God dwells in us by His spirit, just believe it.

It's the Father in you, He does the work.

John 14:13-18

3 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you

John 15:3-8

3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

6 If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.

7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

Jesus intends us to bear the fruit of souls, light and life and the works of Jesus as believers.

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Acts 10:38-39

38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

John 14:12-13

12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

Matt 10:1-2

10 And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

The works Jesus did were good not bad.

The works we do are to cast out unclean spirits, heal the sick, raise the dead, preach saying the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Whatever you freely received, freely give. The kingdom is in you. The supernatural you can expect is for the sick to be healed the oppressed to be free. You never see Jesus putting sickness on people but rather he healed them.

Luke 10:8-10 8 And into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you:

9 And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.

Luke 10:17-18

17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Preach the kingdom of heaven is at hand.
