
STUDENT ACCESS TO HMH SCIENCE


K-5 students will have access to online resources for the new science series from Houghton Mifflin. A HMH Science link to login to that website has been placed under Quick Links for Students on the school homepage.



Clicking on the HMH Science link will take you to the login page


The first time vou access the login page, you will need to select your state and school/district. The correct choices for that are shown at left. Once those are selected, click the Next button. [NOTE: Once you have filled in the state and school/district information on

any given computer, you shouldn't have to do so for future logins unless you clear/reset your browser history.]




As is always the case, you will need to enter a username and password. For K-2 students, a generic grade level username and password will be used for all students. Homeroom teachers will provide parents with that information. Students in grades 3-5 will use their network usernames and passwords.


At the login screen, enter your username and password and click the Sign In button.



The first time you log in on any given computer, you will have to check the two boxes for Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy and click Submit. Feel free to actually read the Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy if you wish. You only have to accept this stuff one time.




Materials for Grade 1 appear by default. For those of you not in Grade 1, don't panic.



Simply use the drop down arrow to select the desired grade level.




At the bottom of your HMH homepage, you will notice a Resources section.
