The <u>School Objective</u> for Spanish at St. Vincent de Paul School is to familiarize students with the Spanish language and the culture of the Spanish speaking countries of the world, prior to taking Spanish 1 in high school.

Students may look up what they missed in class on my webpage for 6th graders, and on my webpage plus on the junior high assignments calendar for 7th and 8th graders.

Missed Daily Work questions, assignments, and quizzes will all need to be made up once the student returns to school. Missed Daily Work questions will be posted on my webpage AFTER all three classes of a grade have answered it in class. Remember: everything I ask you to turn in will be counted as a grade and will affect your overall SVdP G.P.A.
