1. **To be written down or recorded (v.2).**
2. **To be made plain so that others can understand it (v.2).**
3. **To be shared with other individuals (v.2).**
4. **For motivating others toward a common goal (v.2).**
5. **To be acted on or implemented (v.2).**
6. **For a specific time in the future (v.3).**
7. **Not to be discarded (v.3).**
8. **Fail-proof (v.3).**
