## Biblical theology for service

What does the Bible say about service?

- <u>Matt. 5:16</u>: Service is a "tangible" way for people to *recognize* God at work in the world.
- <u>Matt. 20:25-28</u>: Service *liberates* us from self and *identifies* us with Jesus.
- Luke 17:5-10: Service is **expected** of believers.
- <u>1 Cor. 12:4-7</u>: Service is a *Spirit*-inspired activity.

### Biblical theology for service (cont'd.)

What does the Bible say about service?

- <u>Eph. 2:8-10</u>: Service is our response to God's *grace* toward us and is how God *purposed* us to be.
- <u>Eph. 4:11-12</u>: Service is God's prescription for *individual* and *corporate* health and growth.
- <u>1 Peter 4:7-11</u>: Service brings *glory* to God and demonstrates our *alignment* with God.

#### Biblical theology for service (cont'd.)

Taken together, one biblically-oriented theology for service is:

Christian service is a means by which God receives glory through the exercise of faith, as such exercise is undertaken for God's glory and fulfillment of God's purposes in the world.



#### Importance of service to God

A necessary aspect of service that we must not forget, is our service to God. Following are a few notes on the importance of service to God:

- Deut 11:13-17 Service to God reveals God's *providential* plan.
- John 12:25-26 Service to Christ, reveals how God honors those who trust God.
- Rom 12:1 Service to God is an *act* of *worship* that we owe to God.
- 1 Cor 15:58 Service to God is not *wasted*.
- Col 3:23-24 Service *represents* our view of God.
