Community Together (6:1-10)

How can a community develop and maintain its character and strength?

- Shared burdens
- Shared blessings

"A measure of a community's strength is its will to care for one another without losing the soul of any individual."

Community Together (6:1-10)

Shared burdens (1-5)

- I. Fellowship: Restore one another (1) - Matt 18:15-22; James 5:19-20
- II. Love: Bear one another's burdens (2) - John 13:34; 15:12; Gal 5:13-15
- III. Honor one another (3-4) - 2 Cor 10:12-18
- IV. Self: Individual responsibility (5)
 2 Cor 13:5

<u>Community Together (6:1-10)</u> Shared blessings (6-10)

Koinonia – to have in common / fellowship in Christ (see Gal 2:9)

- I. <u>The precept</u>: Share with one another (6)
 Luke 10:7; 1 Cor 9:11, 14
- II. <u>The principle</u>: Sowing and reaping (7-8)

- Give confident of a return. Job 4:8; Prov 22:8; 2 Cor 9:6

- III. <u>The problem</u>: Growing weary (9a) - Lk 18:1; 2 Cor 4:1, 16
- IV. <u>The promise</u>: Go on for good (9b-10) - 2 Cor 4:17

What is the quality of the character I demonstrate in my communities?

How have my communities improved because I am there?





Community at the Cross (6:11-18)

- I. Circumcision has been misused (12-13)
 - A. Pretense as a motivation for ministry
 - B. Persecution as a sign of Christian witness
- II. Christ crucified must be maintained (14-16)
 - A. Reaffirm transformation
 - B. Resolve to trust God
 - C. Reverse the curse



Community at the Cross (6:11-18 cont'd.)

- III. Continuation of ministry (17-18)
 - A. His reason to continue
 - Scars drive him
 - B. Their resolve to continue
 - God's grace for them
