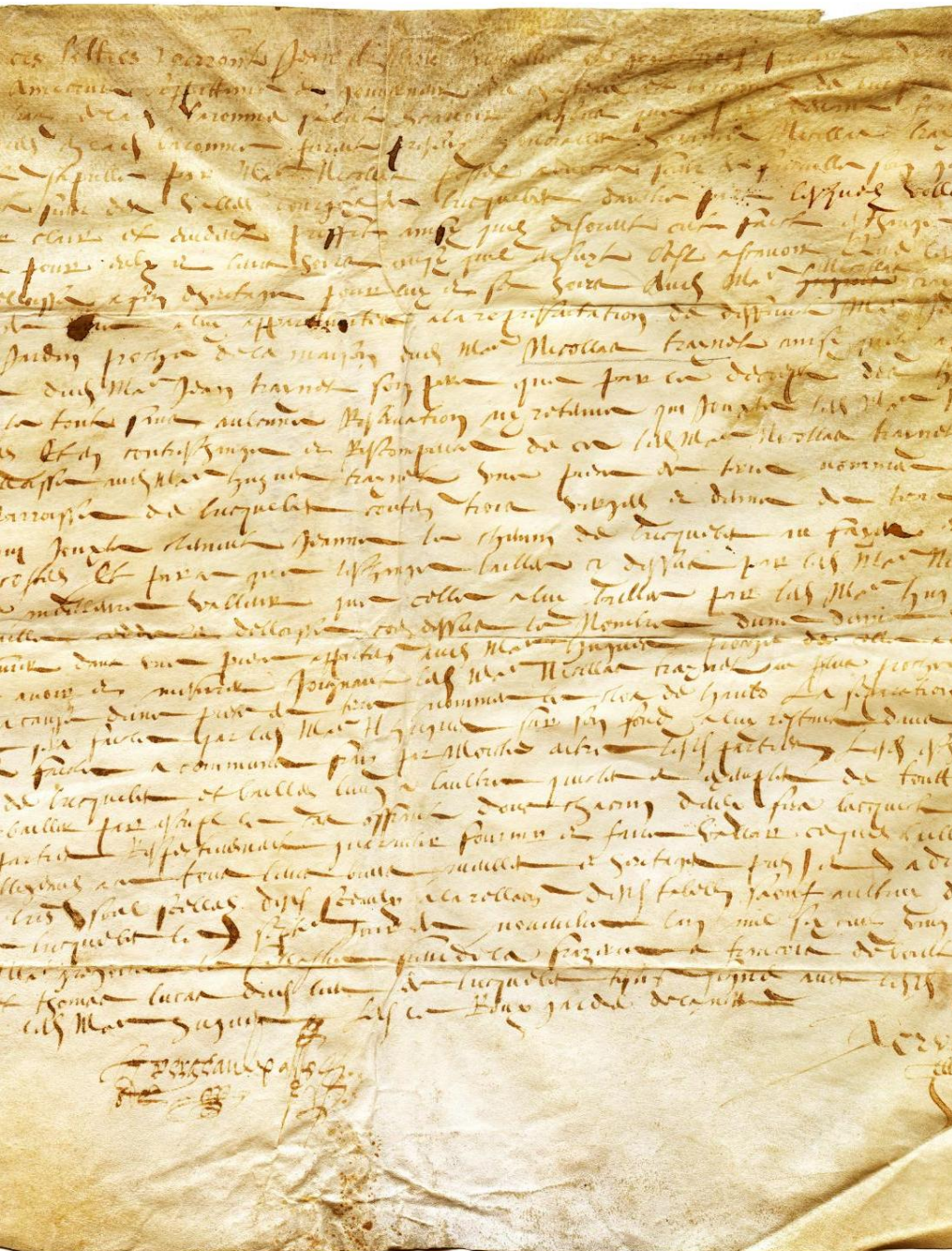

Apostle Paul's Authorship

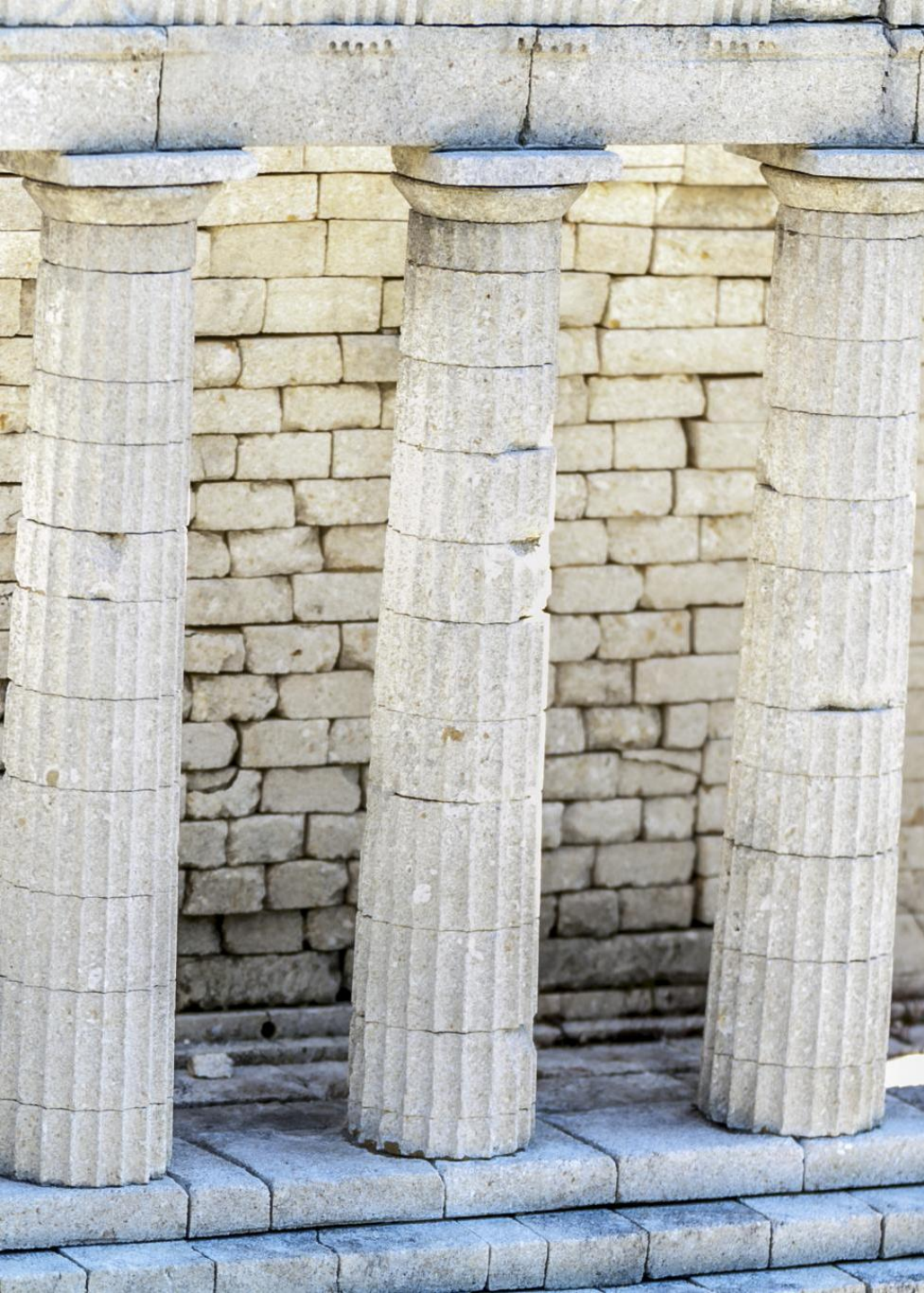
The Book of Philippians is traditionally attributed to Apostle Paul, who is a key figure in early Christianity.

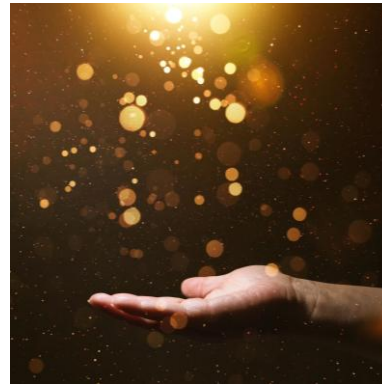

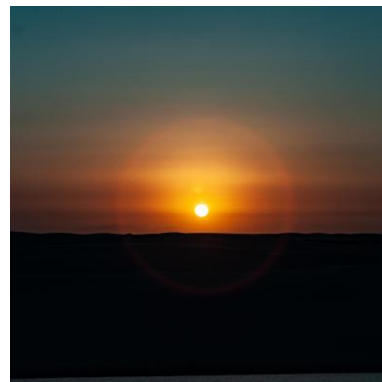
