Paul's Salutation

Formal Greeting

Paul starts his letter with a formal greeting; sets a respectful tone for the message which follows.

Servants of Christ

Self-identification as servants of Christ with an emphasis on commitments, dedication, and authority.

Establishing Authority

This greeting establishes Paul's authority as a leader within the early Christian community. Also establishes a collegial connection with those serving in Philippi.






Expressions of Gratitude

Paul's thanksgiving reflects his joy in the shared faith with the Philippians, highlighting their strong spiritual bond.



Prayer for the Philippians

Spiritual Growth

The Day of Christ

1:6, 10; 2:16

This phrase appears three times in the first two chapters—twice in a span of five verses in chapter one alone. Why?

The Return of the Christ

hémera (Gr.): literally, a day (24-hour period); metaphorically, a measured/controlled period of time denoting the occurrence of a specific event (e.g., an eschatological event)

The 'what' of 'so what?'

What Paul longs for. What believers grow toward.

Despite being in chains, Paul's faith and message reached the imperial guard, influencing many even in captivity.

Paul's circumstances demonstrate how God can use challenging situations for His glory and the advancement of the Gospel.




Encouragement and Boldness in Preaching

Paul finds joy in the fact that Jesus Christ is being preached, emphasizing the importance of the gospel message.


Focus on the Gospel




