
"A spiritual battle rages in every ministry setting." What would be a good response in that situation?

## **Scripture References**

- 1) We start in the Old Testament to get a historical perspective on God's <u>redemptive</u> plan.
- 2) From Isaiah 43:10-12 through Acts 1:8 we see that our part as God's people is to be his <u>witnesses</u>.
- 3) So Psalm 67 makes it clear that God blesses us for a <u>PURPOSE</u>

   and that purpose is to make God known in the <u>whole</u> world.
   God is not just blessing US. He blesses us so that we will be able to <u>share</u> our blessings with the world, to glorify Him.

- 4) Being available for being a witness begins with ministry of presence.
- 5) Believe that it is no <u>accident</u> that you live in a place God has chosen for you to represent Him.
- 6) Proclamation of the gospel will confront darkness.
- 7) A <u>spiritual battle</u> rages in every ministry setting.
- 8) Only <u>God's power</u> can transform a sinful, rebellious heart into a heart of loving worship.
- Only God can forgive and do the powerful work of <u>changing</u> hearts.
- 10) Like Philip we are better representatives of God's values as we partner in ministry, are available, obedient, and prepared.
- 11) Remember that it is God who <u>initiates</u> relationship with us, "For not one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them to me..." (John 6:44)
